Gospel. That is why we are offering two, evangelistic training opportunities in the next two months.





Lunch 'n Learn: "Not Even a Hint" - Sexual Purity

We are happy to report we had 45 pastors joined together to hear Mike Kahn share about the growing epidemic of pornography and sexual immorality in our society and the church. The statistics say that 90 percent of professing Christian men (18-68 years of age) admit to struggling to be sexually pure and 64 percent of them admit that they look at pornography once a month or more. In addition, 76 percent of 18-30 year-old women have indicated that they view pornography once a month or more. With all our mobile devices teens are becoming hooked on pornography like never before.
