PROCEEDINGS

1. The 106th Annual Session of the Tampa Bay Baptist Association opened at 6:45 pm October 24, 2016, at First Baptist Church of Temple Terrace.
2. Pastor Paul Purvis, of First Baptist Church of Temple Terrace, welcomed everyone and opened the meeting with prayer. Pastor Paul prayed especially for Jace, Pastor Chad Driggers' son who is going through chemotherapy for leukemia.
3. Pastor Chad Driggers, Moderator and Pastor of Southside Brandon, called the meeting to session and introduced Buck Buchanan, worship leader from First Baptist of Temple Terrace who lead the congregation in worship.
4. Boe Ellis, Church Planting Catalyst Report
Boe gave his report on the Church Planting Network and stated that Brian Elliott was planting a church in the Channelside area of downtown. The parent church is Christ Fellowship.

Pastor Drew Tucker and a team from Covenant Life Church in South Tampa planted a new church in September, 2016. *The Heights Church* meets in the YMCA at Palm and Florida Avenues.

Boe also mentioned another recent church planter – Kyle Norton out of Bell Shoals Apollo Beach is starting a church plant in Riverview. Fred Eborda is working toward starting a second Filipino church in the Tampa area.

Boe called Pastor Justin Perry of Covenant Life church to share a testimony of what God is doing in his ministry. Justin shared how God used other churches to help them, starting with Pastor Bob Block with First Baptist Tampa. Pastor Bob allowed them to use his church space for 5 years. A door was opened last year for them to rent Palma Ceia Baptist Church and now Covenant Life has revitalized Palma Ceia.

Pastor Joel Vicente came and shared how his recent trip with other pastors to SEND Philadelphia was such a blessing to him. He and the other pastors got to see firsthand the challenges that the church planters are facing. He encouraged people to pray for them, and stated that if they had the opportunity to go, it would be a blessing to them and the church planters.

5. Othoniel Valdes, Language Church Director Report

Othoniel shared how \$268,942.89 had been given out to churches in our Association since 1999 through the Project Jerusalem offering. One hundred seventy three churches have been helped. Othoniel then proceeded to present the grants from the 2016 Project Jerusalem Offerings to the following churches:

An offering for the 2017 Project Jerusalem was collected.

6. After Mike thanked Buck for leading the worship, he then called Othoniel Valdes to honor him for his 19 years of service to the Association. Mike invited everyone to attend a luncheon at the Association on December 5th to officially honor him.

Mike thanked Pastor Paul and his staff for hosting the Celebration event.

Mike announced that Pastor Paul Purvis will be nominated as President of the Pastors Conference at Calvary Church and Dr. Stephen Rummage will be nominated for President of the Florida Baptist Convention.

7. Mike Kahn - Executive Director of Missions Report

Q Place – Effective Relational Evangelism

Mike said several churches are planning on starting this relational evangelism program in January.

Discipleship

The Association continues to encourage discipleship training. A discipleship conference, *Discipleship Blueprint*, took place last month at FBC Temple Terrace. We are seeing discipleship encouraged at every level of our denomination, from the local, state and national levels.

Not Even a Hint

Mike talked about the “Not Even a Hint” campaign kit that he has been working on which addresses sexual immorality in our Nation and our churches. This kit will help pastors address this epidemic problem in our churches and will be available soon.

Revitalization

Covenant Life with Pastor Justin Perry revitalized Palma Ceia BC. Bay Life with Pastor Mark Saunders revitalized FBC Mango.

TBBCC

Mike introduced Directors Eric and Sandra Brown from the Tampa Bay Baptist Conference Center. Eric thanked the Association for the privilege of serving at the Conference Center. He told of, and showed slides of several resources that are available for churches at the Conference Center. Eric also had brochures available.

Florida Baptist Children's Home

Manny Hernandez, Director of Quality Improvement from the Florida Baptist Children's Home said that the Children's Home had been ministering to children and families for over 110 years. In 2015 the Children's Home had the privilege of serving more than 174,000 children through their campuses' various ministries. Manny introduced Jodi, the Director of Foster Care at the Children's home and she thanked the churches for their support in helping them to care for the many children over the years.

Mike introduced Lielson Penido, as the new Church Ministry Director assuming Othoniel's position. This will be effective December 5, 2016.

Jeff Warren Recognition

Mike asked that Jeff Warren, chairman of the Tampa Bay Baptist Foundation come to the platform and be recognized for his faithful service to the Foundation for 19 years. Under his leadership, the Foundation assets grew to exceed one million dollars. (Please see the Foundation-TBBF Report in this Annual Report for more information). Jeff was presented with a Florida Gators' Tim Tebow football jersey.

8. Bobby Patton - Great Commission Catalyst Report

Bobby shared how he and Mike were separately discipling pastors in a 16 week discipleship study.

Leadership Conference – We had over 140 in attendance at our Third Annual Leadership Conference in August.

Preaching Conference – Our TBBA 2016 Preaching Conference was led by Dr. Stephen Rummage with 34 preachers in attendance.

Bobby presented Pastor Bob Block, First Baptist Tampa, with the TBBA grant in honor of Tom Biles in the amount of \$2,500.

At this time, Mike introduced Dr. Tommy Green, president of the Florida Baptist Convention who brought the message.

9. Business

Credentials Committee Recommendation

Bobby Patton presented the recommendation from the Credentials Committee.

Please refer to the bottom of page 3 in your Book of Reports. The Tampa Bay Baptist Association Credentials Committee has met with Pastor Clarence Nathan of New Victory Baptist Church and recommends that his church be received into full fellowship with our Association. This recommendation has already been brought to the Executive Committee and was unanimously approved. There were no questions for discussion and the recommendation was approved.

Nominating Committee Recommendation

Since Pastor Frank Scott was not present, Pastor Chad presented the recommendation. The Tampa Bay Baptist Association Nominating Committee has met and made the nominations that are shown on pages 9-10 in your Book of Reports. The same nominations were unanimously approved at the September Executive Committee meeting. The committee recommends that these nominated individuals be approved as TBBA leaders as shown in the Book of Reports. There were no questions for discussion and the recommendation was approved.

Stewardship Committee Recommendation – Pastor David Whitten

Encouraging and Equipping Pastors, Planters, Leaders

Pastors were encouraged and equipped in many different ways this past year.

Lunch n' Learns

The following Lunch n' Learns were held at the Tampa Bay Baptist Conference Center or TBBA offices and drew many pastors to hear about:

Same Sex Marriage and Your Church - Gary Yeldell
Not Even a Hint (Sexual Purity) – Mike Kahn
Effective Relational Evangelism for the 21st Century/Q Place – Jeff Klein
Urban Ministry Panel Discussion – Chip Luter, Bruce Moore, Joel Vicente

Miscellaneous Ministries

The following luncheons or trainings were offered during the year to inform pastors and leaders of various ministries that could help them fulfill their church's mission.

- One Day Soul Winning Workshop – Dr. David Burton taught 33 pastors and leaders from seven different churches about how to build caring relationships with the lost, depend on the leadership of the Holy Spirit, begin an evangelistic conversation, and clearly share the gospel message. After the training eleven people went out into Sulphur Springs neighborhoods to share the gospel door to door.
- Celebrate Recovery (CR) Luncheon – The state regional director, Earl Burgess spoke about the purpose and benefits of this Christ-centered 12 step program that is designed to help people deal with hurts, habits, and hang-ups. Dr. Stephen Rummage and Pastor David Towner also shared about how CR has impacted many people in their churches.
- CultureLink – Eight different churches (22 pastors and leaders) were equipped in disciple making and in effectively leading an international mission trip.
- Johnny Hunt Men's Conference – FBC Temple Terrace and the TBBA partnered together to offer this conference at FBC Temple Terrace. About 250 men attended and were greatly encouraged and challenged to live godly lives.
- Creating a Missional Strategy – Dr. Craig Culbreth taught many pastors and leaders about how churches can effectively mobilize their members to be on mission in their communities. A free book entitled "Across the Street and Around the World" was mailed to each participant.
- Discipleship Blueprint Conference – FBC Temple Terrace and the TBBA partnered together to offer this conference at FBC Temple Terrace. About 80 pastors and leaders attended and they learned how they can begin and sustain a disciple making movement in their own churches.
- Annual TBBA Leadership Conference (See Bobby Patton report)
- Annual Preaching Conference (See Bobby Patton report)
- Annual Pastors and Wives Christmas Party – Over 90 Pastors and wives attended the annual Christmas party at the Puleo farm. Delicious barbeque, great fellowship, entertainment (saxophone player), and gift cards were enjoyed by all attendees.

Pastors' Discipleship Groups

Mike continues to disciple pastors with the intent that they will in turn disciple their church members. He disciplined three pastors through a 15 week discipleship study this past year. They studied the fundamentals of what it means to be a whole-hearted follower of Christ. These pastors were all given the curriculum that Mike took them through and were encouraged to begin to habitually begin to disciple 2-3 men in their churches who will in turn disciple others, and so on.

TBBA has partnered with the Navigator Church Ministries so that they can provide coaching for pastors who want to be encouraged and held accountable to follow through with the hard work of changing their churches into disciple-making churches.

Pastors' Prayer Gatherings

Since the beginning of 2014 we have been inviting our TBBA pastors to gather once a month in various parts of our county to cry out to the Lord in repentance and to ask Him for personal revival, church-wide revival, and to send a great spiritual awakening in our country.

We continue to invite our pastors to pray each month at three locations:

Tampa Bay Baptist Conference Center – Elbert Nasworthy

Southside Brandon – Chad Driggers

Al Lopez Park – Eloy Rodriguez/Othoniel Valdes (Spanish)

Pastoral Prayer Requests

We emailed 24 Constant Contacts to Senior Pastors to ask them to pray for other pastors or family members as needed throughout the year. It is one of the best ways that we have to keep our pastors connected with and supporting each other.

North American Mission Board

Mike has served on a team of six Directors of Missions from around the country to assist NAMB in reconnecting with DOMs. They have met three times to plan a twice a year national DOM Training Lab and he has met two other times to teach a Breakout Session (Equipping Pastors to Make Disciples) at these labs.

Florida Baptist Convention

Mike coordinated a road trip for 13 local pastors to attend Dr. Tommy Green's first FBC Annual Meeting as the Executive Director. They travelled on the Southside Baptist Church of Brandon bus and stayed in Panama City.

Mike has served on the Florida Baptist Convention State Board of Missions with the Loans Committee. They have met three times at Lake Yale in the past year.

Revitalizations

FBC Mango voted in August of 2014 to be revitalized and has patiently waited for a church to help them. During this past year Bay Life Church in Brandon agreed to revitalize FBC Mango.

Christ Fellowship Church Downtown Brian Elliott Tampa Channelside

Pastor Brian and his wife and brand new baby girl moved into the Channelside district of downtown Tampa to plant our first SBC church in that area. Brian served, and continues to serve on staff with his parent church, Christ Fellowship Tampa, Pastor Bruce Moore.

Bell Shoals Baptist Church Riverview Kyle Norton Riverview

Pastor Kyle and family joined Pastor George Thomasson as a church planting intern at Bell Shoals Apollo Beach in 2015 for the express purpose of preparing to plant the latest Bell Shoals campus in Ruskin. That vision will become a reality on October 30, 2016 as a large team made up of families from multiple Bell Shoals campuses began worshipping in a Ruskin school.

The Heights Church Drew Tucker Tampa Heights

Pastor Drew and a team from Covenant Life Church in South Tampa planted a new church for the Seminole Heights / Tampa Heights Areas in September, 2016. They are meeting in the Bob Gilbertson Central City Family YMCA at Palm and Florida Avenues just north of I-275 downtown.

Redeemer City Church Mitch Kuhn Tampa Heights

Pastor Mitch was equipped and sent out to plant Redeemer City Church in Tampa by Skycrest Community Church, a Southern Baptist Church and Suncoast Association member church in Clearwater, FL.

International Filipino Baptist Church Fred Eborda Tampa

Pastor Fred, with a team of experienced church planters, is planting in the Tampa / Temple Terrace area and currently working on a sponsor-church relationship with Belmont Baptist Church, Pastor Josh Parker.

New Churches

The Tampa Bay Baptist Association Credentials Committee has met with Pastor Clarence Nathan of New Victory Baptist Church and recommends that they be received into our Association. The Executive Committee voted to receive them in our May 16, 2016 meeting.

Church Planter Network (CPN) –Church Planter Network (CPN) was launched to establish a channel of communication for church planters and church planting churches.

This momentum was carried into 2016 as Planters continued to connect online and personally through CPN events including a monthly luncheon, and a Family Christmas party hosted by Christ Fellowship Tampa. From these types of interactions, Planters are fellowshiping, gleaning practical helps, and forging one-to-one relationships that reach beyond a once-a-month event.

Overall, CPN continues to serve as a culture maker, fostering a *family* dynamic. The motto is "you are never alone." The goal is to see this lived out as pastors and their families are encouraged, and as pastors coming in from the outside find CPN as a natural entry-point.

Networking – The Church Planting Catalyst (CPC) has served as a conduit for connections by: 1) driving content online, 2) communicating with and visiting seminaries and the church planters and catalysts there, 3) strengthening relationships with friends at NAMB, the Florida Baptist Convention, other local associations, and churches outside the TBBA, 4) nurturing relationships with CPCs in other parts of the country, and 5) attending and participating in conferences including the Florida Baptist Convention, Renovate, Exponential, The BLVD Training, and other local events. This has proven to be valuable for Tampa church planters who benefit from and connect to resources through the CPC's work.

Philly Partnership– The CPC participated in and provided some coordination for a NAMB-funded "Catch the Vision Tour" in Philadelphia in September, 2016. This two-day visit planted seeds for partners to join with the formal partnership the TBBA already has with the NAMB-SEND->Philly Team.

Workflow and Support – The CPC has worked to help church plants and their sponsor-churches apply for recognition as a Southern Baptist church, and gain financial support from the TBBA and the Florida Baptist Convention.

Church Planting Internships – The CPC continues to work to help churches consider and establish church planting / pastoral internships and residencies as a way to become more intentional about leadership development, personal disciple making and multiplication.

Churches Planting Churches Training – The CPC coordinated a one and a half day "Churches Planting Churches" training in January. Hosted by First Baptist Tampa, the training was led by Pastor Sean Pierce, a D.O.M., planter / pastor and former NAMB Catalyst in Albany, NY.

LANGUAGE CHURCH DIRECTOR – Othoniel Valdes

The Haitian Annual Sunday School Conference was held in March with 7 churches participating and a total of 65 in attendance.

Five Hispanic Congregations participated in the training from the Navigators and the total attendance was 25.

Through Women's Mission and Ministries, ten churches provided 230 backpacks that were distributed to the migrant workers through Iglesia Bautista Peniel in Wimauma.

About eight to ten Hispanic Pastors met for Prayer on the first Wednesday of each month.

GREAT COMMISSION CATALYST – Bobby Patton

The Great Commission Catalyst serves in concert with the DOM to assist our churches and pastors in whatever way possible to more effectively fulfill the Great Commission in our association. He proactively searches for effective curriculum, programs, and resources that can be used to equip pastors and lay leaders to develop healthy, evangelistic churches. Bobby is currently discipling four pastors in a 16 week discipleship study.

Leadership Training

More than 140 participated in the Third Annual Leadership Conference at Seminole Heights Baptist Church. There were nine workshops that were offered including age-graded Sunday School, Discipleship, and Pastors.

TBBA Preaching Conference

Thirty four preachers from the Tampa Bay area attended “Preaching Truth in a Culture of Change” led by Dr. Stephen Rummage, Senior Pastor of Bell Shoals Baptist Church. Engaging the Biblical Text and Engaging the Listener were the two themes for this two-day workshop.

Good Friday Services

Three of our churches hosted the Associational Good Friday services: Brant Adams of Seminole Heights, Elbert Nasworthy of Myrtle Lake, and Joel Vicente of Open Arms. Each service included praise and worship, multiple preachers, and Project Jerusalem offerings.

Pastors’ Stewardship Conference

We had two sessions of Stewardship Training at our office, led by Tim Martin (FBC Middleburg). Thirteen were registered for the morning session and twenty-six in the evening session. Stewardship materials were distributed to all attendees.

World Changers

World Changers exist to serve churches in their mission of making disciples by providing missions experiences that develop the heart of students to serve others. From July 11 – 16, more than 200 *World Changer* participants and volunteers served at 24 ministry locations. They worked on 18 projects, 2 VBS events, and assisted 4 of our churches in construction projects.

Men of Iron Conference

Fourteen pastors and leaders participated in a conference led by Garret Barbush, Executive Director of Men of Iron. This training session was taken from Proverbs 27:17 - helping men in mentoring men by strengthening their relationships with God, family, and the church and thus helping men grow toward a biblical standard of manhood.

WOMEN’S MISSIONS AND MINISTRIES REPORT – Carol Clark, Director

In August of 2016 we held our women’s breakout session at the annual TBBA Equipping Leadership Conference at Seminole Heights Baptist Church. The response of women attending our “Women Discipling Women” breakout session was overwhelming. We continued the training monthly during 2016 with over 10 churches participating. Since that time we have hosted two women’s ministry leader roundtables to bring our churches together to discuss how to minister to women and children and encourage their participation in missions and ministries. Over 20 churches participated. Our plans are to become more connected in ministry and education, coming alongside one another by equipping and encouraging.

As a result of much prayer and the Association hosting two Pastors’ Wives appreciation events, several of our pastors’ wives have felt led to meet with other pastors’ wives on a regular basis over a meal,

sponsored by the Association. The pastors' wives have also planned and hosted their own association-wide events during 2016. All pastors' wives are invited to come together and meet to encourage one another.

We also hosted the Florida Baptist Convention Women's Missions & Ministries sponsored "Making Memories" regional event in March for mothers and daughters at Carrollwood Baptist Church. With participants and volunteers, we had 90 people in attendance. The girls & their moms learned about the Oasis Pregnancy Center and the Fish Company (a sewing ministry) and helped these ministries by bringing in donated items as well as making items used in the ministries, such as twin dolls and encouragement books. Florida Baptist Convention Camp Worldlight staff were on hand to play games, do chalk art, and talk about camp this summer. There was a photo booth, bonfire, crafts, and a luau as well as other fun activities experienced at this weekend especially designed with moms & daughters in mind.

ADMINISTRATIVE COMMITTEE REPORT – Eloy Rodriguez, Chairman

The Administrative Committee met twice this past year. They received and discussed staff performance reviews, evaluated the Executive Director of Missions, and discussed and took action on the following personnel issues.

Othoniel is transitioning from being a part-time Language Church Catalyst at TBBA to being a full-time pastor at Bell Shoals Hispanic Church. This will take place on January 1, 2017. As a result the Committee interviewed and approved the hiring of Lielson Penido to take Othoniel's place as the part-time Language Ministry Catalyst.

Also, the Executive Director of Missions recommended to the Administrative Committee that due to the need to pay off the new \$54,000 office roof in 2017 there should be no TBBA staff raises in 2017. The Administrative Committee agreed and recommended to the Stewardship Committee that there be no raises for the TBBA staff but that the TBBC directors receive a slight salary increase.

BAPTIST COLLEGIATE MINISTRIES

This past year we saw a #MovementofGod take place through the students at the BCM! We would like to share just some of what God has been doing in and through our ministry over the last year:

- 4,681 collegians reached.
- 44 salvations (Our highest ever!) of college students.
- We assisted 30 local churches throughout the year by providing opportunities for students and internationals to connect to a local body of believers. We had gym nights, potluck dinners, Disciple Nows and many other ways of connecting students to churches.
- 968 Internationals reached through Friends of Internationals.

Did you hear the story of Zach?

If you were to have asked Zach this time last year what he believed, he would say he was a Universalist, someone who believes in all beliefs. He came to the BCM after one of our leaders invited him during orientation. Zach would say that he "found the Christians at BCM to be genuine and really caring." This made Zach join one of our small group Bible studies. Through this process he started going to church and ended up joining a D-group because he was interested in how the people at church and BCM were treating him.

While in the D-Group one day he learned that Christ died for Him and because of that we can have joy. At that point it clicked! He realized why everyone around him was happy and had joy. It was because Jesus rose from the grave and invites us into a relationship with Him. Soon after that, Zach gave his life to Christ! Since that decision, Zach has been baptized and is now working at his church!

CONFERENCE CENTER REPORT – Eric & Sandra Brown, Directors

God again blessed us with 12 summer camps this year and numerous youth and adult retreats. From September 2015 to August 2016, we estimate that there were approximately 400 groups and over 40,000 people on the grounds, excluding the thousands of participants in sports practices and games. There were also 1,070 summer camp attendees.

We have 6 motel rooms, with basic cable and Wi-Fi, which can sleep up to 24 people and 2 dorm buildings that can accommodate up to 152 people. Our chapel, as well as several meeting spaces, is available for a variety of events and we offer food service in the dining hall for retreats and summer camps.

Recreational amenities include a swimming pool, a gymnasium that can accommodate 3 simultaneous volleyball games or a full-court basketball game, football/soccer/baseball field, 5 beach volleyball courts, human Foosball court, obstacle course, Ga-Ga, an 18 hole putt-putt course, canoes/kayaks/paddle-boats, 20 full hook-up RV sites, bonfire rings, picnic pavilions and boat launch with a 70-foot floating fishing dock.

New to the facility this year is the addition of 24 Bubble Balls for groups to have parties in the gymnasium playing soccer or any other game they can imagine. The cost for a 2-hour party in our air conditioned gym is only \$200. The reviews we have had thus far indicate that it is a hit with our younger visitors and our adults as well. We also received a very generous donation; a 2013 Regal Bowrider boat which guests can rent to water ski or pull an inner tube.

We love to bless pastors and their wives and offer 1 free night per year in our motel and a discounted rate of \$20 per night thereafter. We also offer 1 free night annually in the dorms to youth groups in exchange for a mission project on the Conference Center grounds the following day.

FOUNDATION (TBBF) REPORT – Jeff Warren, Chairman

The mission of the Foundation is to assist and support the Southern Baptist churches that are members of the Association in proclaiming the gospel of Jesus Christ in the Tampa Bay area and beyond.

In early 2016 the Executive Director of Missions proposed to the TBBF that they might evaluate their financial report at the end of each calendar year. Then based on that report they might determine an amount of funds to release to the TBBA in the next calendar year so that the TBBA staff can more effectively

- Encourage Pastors
- Equip Leaders
- Multiply churches

The Foundation graciously and unanimously agreed with this proposal. Their annual financial grant will

never cut into the principal of the TBBF but will come out of the previous year's earnings and fund raiser(s) - TBBF Annual Golf Tournament, etc.

In 2016 the Foundation generously gave the TBBA \$30,000 in March and will give an additional \$20,000 in October.

Some of the ways that these generous gifts were used in 2016 are as shown below:

Some church planters received funds to assist them.

Two pastors received funds for partial seminary tuition.

Three pastors were assisted so that they could attend the Southern Baptist Convention in St. Louis.

One pastor received monthly pastoral assistance to help revitalize his church.

Two pastors received funding for Navigator Church Ministry coaching (See the Director of Missions report).

The below ministries mentioned in the Director of Missions report were partially funded by the TBBF:

- Preaching Conference
- Johnny Hunt Men's Conference
- Discipleship Blueprint
- Twenty pastors and their children attended a Tampa Bay Rays baseball game together.

In addition, the TBBF gave \$5,000 to the annual Project Jerusalem offering. This offering is dispersed to approved TBBA churches that are in need. They also provided \$2,500 to a deserving church in honor of our previous Executive Director of Missions, Tom Biles.

At the end of 2016, Jeff Warren will resign after 19 years of skillful and faithful leadership as chairman of the TBBF. Under his leadership, the Foundation grew from a handful of members to about 20 members and the assets grew to exceed one million dollars. The Executive Director of Missions and the Foundation members are very grateful for his friendship, counsel, and sacrificial leadership.
