



Contextual Clarity: Understanding your community and the unique

doorways and platforms for the Gospel

Hal Haller, Church Planting Director of the New York Baptist Convention, addressed a number of church planters and pastors in our Association in a special training on the effective contextualization of the Gospel. He challenged us to connect with the people of Tampa Bay as the Apostle Paul connected with the people of Athens in Acts 17.

Reject what is evil:

Receive what is good:

We should then say, "I have been given an assignment. I need to learn from people in my community about what is important to them. Can you tell me something that is important to you and why?" Later, we should write down what they said was important to them.
