

The TBBA in partnership with the Navigators presented a discipleship conference over the weekend of April 28-29, 2017. Special thanks to FBC Tampa for hosting us and to Brian Zaas and Jeff Edwards of Navigators Church Ministries for leading. We are pleased to offer below a wrap-up of the Conference.

We are praising God for an amazing turnout to the GiDC Conference for the Tampa Bay Baptist Association (TBBA). This was the first large stage TBBA/NCM partnership. Some 170 participants were on hand, including the NCM staff who stayed to help after two days of training. More importantly, 35 churches in the Tampa area were represented with both English and Spanish-speaking participants. A huge thank you to all who made it possible from preparation of the conference guide, to workshop presenters, plenary speakers, and all the behind-the-scenes servants of the Lord.

Pastor Kahn, emcee and host from the TBBA, stated that NCM has been an official partner of the TBBA for the last year and that the TBBA is committed to financially helping pastors who want NCM to work with them individually.

Two local pastors, Dr. Stephen Rummage of Bell Shoals Baptist Church, and Pastor Paul Purvis of FBC Temple Terrace hit home runs with their plenary messages on *The Picture of a Disciple* and *Pathways for Making Disciples*. Both are personally discipling men one on one or in triads and are leading their staff and members to do the same.
