

Update on Esser, Spanish Biblical Institute



On October 20, 2017 we had our first Student orientation day with 30 students. On October 23 we had 15 professors in attendance for our teacher's training with the President of the Seminary of Republican Dominican, who flew in just for us.

The next day, (October 24) we kicked off ESSER with an official opening class for everyone, not only the students, and had an attendance of more than 70 people.

Our first classes launched on Saturday, October 28 with nine students, and another class in the Wimauma area had 17 students. Finally, in our first Monday night class, October 30, we had 30 students present.

"The donated goodie bags have all been distributed! We used them to connect with students during the beginning weeks of school, on Wednesdays at Bull Market, and during our Engage 24 event in October. We've made hundreds of connections and the gospel has been shared countless times. During Engage 24 alone, we encouraged students walking by our designated area to summarize their life in one word. After they provided an answer, we gave them a bag and attempted to share the gospel. Within the first couple of hours, our team had already shared the gospel with a Buddhist, a Muslim, a former Catholic, a Jehovah's Witness, and a number of students from nonreligious backgrounds. The bags were a huge success as the students loved receiving little items essential to productive studying! Thank you so much!!"
