107th Annual Session Tampa Bay Baptist Association

October 15, 2017 Host: First Baptist Church of Brandon

PROCEEDINGS

- 1. The 107^h Annual Session of the Tampa Bay Baptist Association opened at 5:00 pm October 15, 2017, at First Baptist Church of Brandon.
- 2. Pastor Tim Keith, of First Baptist Church of Brandon, welcomed everyone and opened the meeting with prayer.
- 3. Pastor Justin Perry, Moderator and Pastor of Covenant Life Church, called the meeting to session. Pastor Justin spoke of the passage in Mark 5 where after Jesus had driven demons out of a man, He told him to go back to his people and "tell them the story" of what Jesus had done for him. Thus, the theme tonight will be "Tell the Story". The different testimonies will reflect the goodness and grace of the Lord as we partner together to share His gospel. He introduced the Haitian choir that told their story in song, followed by the Brazilian choir that did the same.

4. Church Planting Catalyst – Robert Beckman

Robert gave highlights from the Book of Reports on recent church planters.

Zelvis Applin Pastor of South Hills Church sponsored by South Tampa Fellowship told the story of how God called him to Sun City Center where the average age was 55 and over. He questioned God in doing this, since he really had a heart for ministering to teens. However, as he continued to be obedient in preaching, God opened more opportunities for him to minister in Wimauma reaching teens in that neighborhood. His ministry now is reflecting the different cultures that God has opened up to him. They started the work in January, and thus far have seen 15 professions of faith and will soon have a baptism service. He thanked God for the Association and for all the support and help they have offered him.

Slides were shown about the NAMB website with the map of the different SEND cities and the church planters in each of these cities. Robert encouraged everyone to go to the NAMB site (NAMB.net/send-cities to see how they could get involved with sponsoring/praying for the many church planters.

He introduced James Peoples (NAMB – South Florida). James thanked everyone for their support, and told how he felt the Lord calling him to resign his church and be a full time missionary to South Florida through NAMB. He encouraged everyone to help encourage the church planters in South Florida (Miami) as it is an amazing opportunity to help serve alongside the church planters there.

5. Language Ministry Catalyst – Lielson Penido

Lielson mentioned several highlights from the Book of Reports (page 4).

At their first Hispanic Men's Conference in January they had over 200 men to attend.

A new Hispanic church was planted in March with 65 people and Leilson thanked Pastor Joe Alain for allowing them to meet at Carrollwood Baptist.

A video was shown about "ESSER" and Lielson explained that this was a partnership agreement between the TBBA and the Theological Baptist Seminary of the Dominican Republic, and the Southeastern Baptist Theological Seminary. The classes will start on Tuesday, October 24, and will train Spanish members to become godly leaders in their churches. In additional, ESSER provides an opportunity to acquire an Associate's degree in theology for a reasonable price.

Worship song led by David Shenning (Worship Leader, FBC Brandon) and praise team

6. Great Commission Catalyst – Bobby Patton

Bobby called Brant Adams to give a testimony of what the Lord is doing in his ministry at Seminole Heights Baptist Church. Brant first thanked the Association staff for investing in his life and giving him opportunities and tools to grow.

Pastor Roger Bunner of West Broad Street thanked the TBBA for coming alongside him and for the many resources that the TBBA has provided for him and his church.

Bobby then referred to highlights from the Book of Reports (page 3). He mentioned that the Leadership Conference in August was well attended with over 160 attendees. Bobby spoke of a new tool, Pray4everyhome, which is a neighborhood prayer ministry that involves saved people praying for their neighbors by name on a daily basis. He also mentioned another ministry similar to Pray4everyhome, called BlessEveryHome, which is also another great tool. At this time, a video was shown on Pray4everyhome.

Bobby called Pastor Dan Reid of Journey Church to receive the 2017 Tom Biles TBBF grant. Bobby shared about the history of the Project Jerusalem offering. Three churches were presented grants from Project Jerusalem.

An offering for the 2018 Project Jerusalem was collected.

A video from the Florida Baptist Convention was shown regarding the Disaster Relief ministry after Hurricane Irma.

Emily Petrilli of the Florida Baptist Children's Home came and thanked everyone for their part in helping the Florida Baptist Children's Home impact a total of 171, 273 children and individuals in the name of Christ. She shared many statistics of the different ministries under the umbrella of the Florida Baptist Children's Home.

Worship song led by David Shenning and the praise team.

7. Mike Kahn - Executive Director of Missions Report

Mike thanked Pastor Tim Keith, David Shenning and the praise team, and the two choirs that sang. Then he called Pastor David Towner and his wife Tonya to give their testimony of the faithfulness of the Lord in their lives.

Pastor David and Tonya shared how about four years ago he was diagnosed with cancer and last year a staff member of their church had committed a sexual crime and was now serving time, and more recently, Tonya was hit by a car while holding their grandson in a parking lot. She sustained many injuries but is better (their grandson sustained no injuries). They thanked the Association for inviting them to a free Pastors and wife retreat for a weekend in September. They said that with all they had been going through, it was a much needed blessing.

Pastor Carl Ellison, First Baptist of New Tampa shared how God had called him last year to become the pastor of FBC of New Tampa. Since that time, God has blessed his church and ministry, and said there was a fresh wind in the church and that God is at work. He thanked the Association for the many resources that were made available to him through the relationship that was formed between them.

Mike then mentioned some highlights from the Book of Reports. *Not Even a Hint* Sexual Purity Campaign – A free *Not Even a Hint* Purity Campaign workbook was made available to each attendee. (Page 1)

As a follow-up to the Conference, TBBA has partnered with the Navigator Church Ministries (NCM) so that they can provide coaching for pastors who want to be encouraged and held accountable with the work of growing their churches to become disciple-making churches. (Page 1) Mike thanked Pastor Bob Block for hosting the Discipleship Conference at FBC Tampa in April. It was attended by over 140 people from 20 churches.

Mike then thanked Pastor Justin Perry for his leadership as Moderator and said because of his leadership, they were now starting round table discussions at the Executive Committee meetings which encourages pastors to share in discussions of a particular topic at the meetings.

Mike shared that he had started having luncheons in August with the larger TBBA church pastors as the needs of smaller, medium-sized, and larger churches are different. This allows the pastors of the larger churches to get to know one another and discuss topics that affect the larger churches. (Page 2)

A September pastors/wife marriage retreat took place at Innisbrook Golf & Country Club in September free of charge thanks to several generous donors. Twenty couples attended and were greatly encouraged.

At the time of the writing of the Book of Reports, there were no reported revitalizations; however, since that time, we do have a revitalization taking place at Stonewall Baptist Church and The Heights.

The Tampa Bay Baptist Conference Center – The TBBCC continues to bless churches and families and reported that after summer camps, there were 63 professions of faith. (See page 7)

The Tampa Bay Baptist Foundation continues to bless our association with monies to enable us to do ministry with our churches. The Foundation has given the Association \$50,000 in 2017, thus enabling the TBBA to better fulfill its ministry.

Mike called Pastor Paul Purvis to say a few words about the Pastors Prayer Summit that will take place at FBC Temple Terrace in February of next year.

Moderator Pastor Justin Perry called everyone into a brief time of business.

Business

Credentials Committee Recommendation

Manuel Diaz came to the platform and made the following recommendation.

The Tampa Bay Baptist Association Credentials Committee has met with Pastor Mark Warren of Richland Baptist Church, (Page 3). It is recommended that this church be received into full fellowship with our Association. This recommendation has already been brought to the Executive Committee on September 18, 2017 and was unanimously approved. The recommendation was again unanimously approved by the messengers at the Annual Celebration.

Nominating Committee Recommendation – Pastor Tim Encinosa

Since Terry Lowe of the Nominating Committee could not be present, Pastor Tim Encinosa presented the recommendation to approve the nominations that are shown on pages 9-10 in the Book of Reports. The Tampa Bay Baptist Association Nominating Committee has met and made the nominations that are shown on pages 9-10 in your Book of Reports. The same nominations were unanimously approved at the September Executive Committee meeting. There were no questions for discussion and the recommendation was approved.

Stewardship Committee Recommendation – Pastor Tim Encinosa

Pastor Tim took a few minutes to present an overview and some highlights of the budget that is shown on page 11 in the Book of Reports. Pastor Tim thanked everyone for their giving to the Association over the past year and said that slight raises would be given to the TBBA staff next year and also that the roof replacement to the TBBA was paid off. Because of the designated gifts that were received, it will enable the TBBA to do more ministry. The proposed budget has already been unanimously approved at the September Executive Committee Meeting. The Tampa Bay Baptist Association Stewardship Committee recommended the approval of the proposed 2018 TBBA budget that is shown in the Book of Reports. There were no questions for discussion and the recommendation was approved.

Nominations for Moderator-Elect

Pastor Daniel Duncan of Balm BC came to the platform to make a nomination for Moderator-Elect. Pastor Daniel's recommendation was Pastor David Whitten (FishHawk Fellowship Church). Since there were no other recommendations, a motion was made and seconded for Pastor David Whitten to become Moderator Elect for 2017-2018.

Mike presented Pastor Justin with a plaque and thanked him for his leadership as Moderator in 2016-17. Mike reminded everyone that next year's Annual Celebration will take place at First Baptist Church of Wesley Chapel on October 21, 2018.

Mike welcomed Pastor Tim Encinosa as the new Moderator and asked him to close in prayer.

REPORTS

DIRECTOR OF MISSIONS REPORT - Mike Kahn

Encouraging and Equipping Pastors, Planters, Leaders

Pastors were encouraged and equipped in many different ways this past year. Some of the highlights are shown below.

- In late 2016, Pastor Paul Purvis spoke to many pastors at a TBBA luncheon about how the Lord is leading FBC Temple Terrace to be a "house of prayer for the nations". Their Wednesday night service is a 75 minute prayer service that includes worship, intimate prayer times directed by scripture readings, times of personal reflection and repentance, intercession for spiritual awakening, revival, evangelism, missions, and more.
- Not Even a Hint Purity Campaign Mike taught over 50 pastors and leaders about how they could have a church-wide campaign to address the epidemic of pornography and sexual immorality in the church. A free Not Even a Hint Purity Campaign workbook was given to each attendee. The workbook contains sermons on purity, guidelines on conducting a church-wide campaign, small group resources, and helps for protecting members from pornography on their mobile devices.
- Annual Pastors Prayer Summit Fifteen TBBA pastors and leaders attended this annual prayer summit in St. Petersburg. All were spiritually renewed in their personal fellowship with the Lord and in their commitment to lead their churches to be stronger in prayer.
- Growing an Intentional Disciple Making Culture The TBBA and Navigator Church Ministries (NCM) partnered together to offer this conference at FBC of Tampa. About 140 people attended from over 20 churches and they were taught in large groups by Dr. Stephen Rummage, Pastor Paul Purvis, and Bill Mowry. There were many breakout sessions that the attendees went to and some of the pastors who attended are being coached by NCM staff so that they will be able to grow an intentional disciple making church.
- CultureLink Seven pastors and leaders were equipped in disciple making and in effectively leading an international mission trip.
- Covenant Eyes Accountability About 35 pastors and leaders met for lunch and heard Vergil Morgan speak on behalf of Calvary Church in Clearwater about how they provide Covenant Eyes internet protection for all their pastoral and leadership staff. This action has affected the entire church body as it is now more commonly accepted that every believer should use accountability software to protect himself/herself and their family from this problem.
- Johnny Hunt Men's Conference FBC Temple Terrace and the TBBA partnered together to offer this second annual conference at FBC Temple Terrace. About 250 men attended and were greatly encouraged and challenged to live godly lives.
- Under the leadership of Moderator, Pastor Justin Perry, each Executive Committee Meeting of 2017 was modified to include a roundtable discussion of a particular topic. In February we distributed the book, *The Art of Neighboring* to the attendees and discussion followed on how to lead our members to love their neighbors as themselves. In May we discussed the website pray4everyhome.org and talked about how we can lead our members to pray for and witness to their lost neighbors. In September, we gave out the book, *Evangelism* and discussed what an evangelistic culture looks like in the local church.
- Larger Church Pastors' luncheons Some of the needs of smaller, medium-sized, and larger churches are different. Therefore, Mike started a luncheon in August for the TBBA pastors whose churches average over 1000 in attendance. They eat together and then discuss topics that will help them lead their churches to better impact our region and the nations with the gospel.
- First Annual Pastors and Wives Retreat Twenty couples attended a two night marriage retreat at the Innisbrook Resort in Palm Harbor. This was made possible through two very generous gifts

and through the generosity of the TBBA, the Tampa Bay Baptist Foundation, and the Florida Baptist Convention. Darin Saley led four large group sessions that encouraged the couples to strengthen their marriages and then the couples were encouraged to enjoy some date times together.

- Annual TBBA Leadership Conference (See Bobby Patton report)
- Annual Preaching Conference (See Bobby Patton report)
- Annual Pastors and Wives Christmas Party Over 80 Pastors and wives attended the annual Christmas party at the Puleo farm. Delicious barbeque, great fellowship, and gift cards were enjoyed by all attendees.

Pastors' Discipleship Groups

Mike continues to disciple pastors with the intent that they will in turn disciple their church members. He discipled three pastors through a 15 week discipleship study this past year. They studied the fundamentals of what it means to be a whole-hearted follower of Christ. These pastors were all given the curriculum that Mike took them through and were encouraged to begin to habitually begin to disciple 2-3 men in their churches who will in turn disciple others, and so on.

Pastors' Prayer Gatherings

TBBA pastors continue to gather once a month in various parts of our county to cry out to the Lord in repentance and to ask Him for personal revival, church-wide revival, and to send a great spiritual awakening in our country.

North American Mission Board and DOMs

Mike continues to serve on a team of Directors of Missions from around the country to assist NAMB in reconnecting with DOMs. He taught a Breakout Session (Equipping Pastors to Make Disciples) at one lab and attended another lab this past year.

Florida Baptist Convention

Mike continues to serve on the Florida Baptist Convention State Board of Missions with the Loans Committee. They have met at Lake Yale and at the new offices in Jacksonville this past year.

Revitalizations

There are no revitalizations to report this year but much is going on in this area. There are currently three churches that are prayerfully considering being revitalized by a TBBA church.

GREAT COMMISSION CATALYST – Bobby Patton

The Great Commission Catalyst serves in concert with the DOM to assist our churches and pastors in whatever ways possible to more effectively fulfill the Great Commission in our association. He proactively searches for effective curriculum, programs, and resources that can be used to equip pastors and lay leaders to develop healthy, evangelistic churches.

Pastors' Discipleship Groups

Bobby continues to disciple pastors with the intent that they will in turn disciple their church members. He discipled three pastors through a 15 week discipleship study this past year. They studied the fundamentals of what it means to be a whole-hearted follower of Christ.

Leadership Training

We had more than 160 participate in the Fourth Annual Leadership Conference at Seminole Heights Baptist Church. There were ten workshops that were offered including age-graded Sunday School, Discipleship, Pastors, Administration, Technical ministries and Small Groups. Thanks go out to the Seminole Heights' staff and volunteers who helped to make this event such a great success.

Good Friday Services

Three of our churches hosted the Associational Good Friday services: Brant Adams of Seminole Heights, Elbert Nasworthy of Myrtle Lake, and Dan Reid of Journey Church. Each service included praise and worship, multiple preachers, and Project Jerusalem offerings.

Pastors' Stewardship Conference

We had two sessions of Stewardship Training at our office, led by Pastor Rod Taylor (Stewardship Pastor from Idlewild). Eighteen were registered for the morning session and five in the evening session. Stewardship materials were distributed to all attendees and two Financial Peace University (FPU) Leadership kits were purchased by the association so that churches can check them out and lead their people through FPU small groups.

World Changers

World Changers exist to serve churches in their mission of making disciples by providing missions experiences that develop the heart of students to serve others. From July 8 – 15, more than 125 World Changer participants served at 10 ministry locations along with 14 volunteers. They worked on 12 projects, 2 VBS events, and assisted 6 of our churches in projects. Highlights from this summer World Changers (all projects) 2017: Professions of Faith 42, Gospel Presentations 856, and 63 people requesting prayer.

Preacher's Conference

This annual conference was cancelled and rescheduled for January 19-20, 2018 due to Hurricane Irma. Pastor Stephen Rummage will teach this conference for the second year in a row.

New Churches

The Tampa Bay Baptist Association Credentials Committee has met with Pastor Mark Warren of Richland Baptist Church and recommends that they be received into our Association. The Executive Committee voted to receive them in our September 18, 2017 meeting.

This partnership will allow us to use all the material and resources provided by the TBS of RD, where every student, upon completing the course, will receive a certified certificate in an Associate degree in Theology. Those who apply can continue their studies for a bachelor degree online and eventually a master in theology by Southeastern Baptist Theological Seminary for only \$2100.

ESSER Biblical Institute Start

October 23 we will start our Biblical Institute with an inaugural class at Peace Baptist Church with the presence and lecture from our President, Pastor Otto Sanchez, from the Dominican Republic.

- The Pastors' Wives gathered for an annual Spring Brunch at the TBBA on April 29. It was a casual relaxing morning with sisters in ministry. The topic was: Brewing Balance in Marriage and Ministry, with guest speakers and licensed mental health counselors, Virginia Pignato and Vickie Carver of Family God's Way, a ministry dedicated to growing Biblical households. There was good food, prizes, and giveaways and most importantly, building lasting friendships. The Baptist Collegiate Ministry (BCM) began the 2017-2018 school year at the University of South Florida (USF) with significant connections. In the first couple of weeks of the fall semester, the BCM, along with its partnership ministry, Friends of Internationals (FOI), connected with hundreds of freshmen and new students from across the state, nation, and world. Conversations about the BCM began over the summer and continued into the weeks leading up to classes beginning and throughout the move-in process.

These significant connections have contributed to the BCM's increased reach on and off campus. During the 2016-17 calendar year, our group celebrated:

- 278 Students in Bible Studies
- 41 Salvations
- 41 Students Serving on Mission

Continuing in this vein, the BCM's goal for the 2017-2018 academic year consists of, as Paul says in 1 Thessalonians 4:1, a "more and more" mentality. Paul said "Finally, then, brothers, we ask and urge you in the Lord Jesus, that as you received from us how you ought to walk and to please God, just as you are doing, that you do so more and more." At our weekly worship gatherings, we've challenged our students to be a "more and more" type Christian in three areas: Jesus, influence, and community. As a result, in the first couple of weeks, the BCM has been given the opportunity for a "more and more" type ministry with students and the administration at USF.

Be in prayer for the BCM as gospel ministry continues. Throughout this semester, students will be engaged in gospel conversations with students and faculty from around the world. In addition to everyday conversations, the BCM and FOI will facilitate weekly and semester programming. Programming

includes worship gatherings on Thursday nights, meals on Sunday afternoons, mid-week Bible studies, conversation groups, a fall-retreat, leadership development, outreach, mission trips, and other strategically planned events.

Students and leaders within the BCM value the partnership they have with local churches. We pray that this continues through attendance, meals, joined mission trips, and more!

CONFERENCE CENTER REPORT – Eric & Sandra Brown, Directors

The Tampa Bay Baptist Conference Center is located on approximately 76 acres of land in the midst of north Tampa. Once on the property it's hard to believe that you are still in the city. From the moment you enter the grounds you experience a quiet country setting. We are surrounded by natural wetlands and beautiful trees line the property. The lake provides a breathtaking view, along with giving our guests plenty of opportunities for fishing, boating and swimming.

God blessed us with 14 camps attended by 18 different groups during our summer camp season this year and numerous youth and adult retreats. From September 2016 to August 2017, we estimate that there were more than 200 groups and over 40,000 people on the grounds, excluding the thousands of participants in sports practices and games. 890 people attended summer camp this year with 63 decisions made for the Kingdom that we know of. The kitchen staff and volunteers served over 8,500 meals during this camp season.

We have 6 motel rooms, with basic cable and Wi-Fi, which can sleep up to 24 people and 2 dorm buildings that can accommodate up to 152 people. Our chapel, as well as several meeting spaces, is available for a variety of events and we offer food service in the dining hall for retreats and summer camps.

Recreational amenities include a swimming pool, a gymnasium that can accommodate 3 simultaneous volleyball games or a full-court basketball game, football/soccer/baseball field, 5 beach volleyball courts, human Foosball court, obstacle course, Ga-Ga, an 18 hole putt-putt course, canoes/kayaks/paddle-boats, a 2013 Regal Bowrider boat which guests can rent to water ski or pull an inner tube, 10 Bubble Balls for groups to have parties in the gymnasium playing soccer or any other game they can imagine, 20 full hook-up RV sites, bonfire rings, picnic pavilions and boat launch with a 70-foot floating fishing dock.

We love to bless pastors and their wives and offer one free night per year in our motel and a discounted rate of \$20 per night thereafter. We also offer one free night annually in the dorms to youth groups in exchange for a mission project on the Conference Center grounds the following day.

FOUNDATION (TBBF) REPORT - Rick Nielsen, Chairman

The mission of the Foundation is to assist and support the Southern Baptist churches that are members of the Association in proclaiming the gospel of Jesus Christ in the Tampa Bay area and beyond.

In 2017 the Foundation assisted and supported our churches by generously giving the TBBA \$25,000 in March and it will give an additional \$25,000 in late October. These gifts were used to

- Encourage Pastors

- Equip Leaders
- Multiply churches

Some of the ways that these generous gifts were used in 2017 are as shown below:

Twenty TBBA pastors and their wives attended our first annual Marriage Retreat at the beautiful Innisbrook Resort.

Some church planters received funds to assist them.

Two pastors received funds for partial seminary tuition.

Two pastors were assisted so that they could attend the Southern Baptist Convention in Phoenix.

One pastor received monthly pastoral assistance to help pay for a part-time Youth Leader.

Four pastors will soon receive funding for Navigator Church Ministry coaching.

One pastor received funding for Prayer Coaching through the Strategic Renewal Ministry.

The below ministries mentioned in the Director of Missions report were partially funded by the TBBF:

- Fifteen TBBA pastors attending the Strategic Renewal Prayer Summit in St. Pete
- CultureLink training
- Growing an Intentional Disciple Making Culture
- Johnny Hunt Men's Conference
- Evangelism Training at Idlewild on October 23, 2017
- Annual Church Planter and family Christmas Party
- Annual Pastor and Wives Christmas Party

From the \$50,000 given to the TBBA in 2017, \$5,000 of it goes to support the annual Project Jerusalem offering which is used to help TBBA churches that are in need. In addition, \$2,500 of it is given to a deserving church in honor of our previous Director of Missions, Tom Biles.
