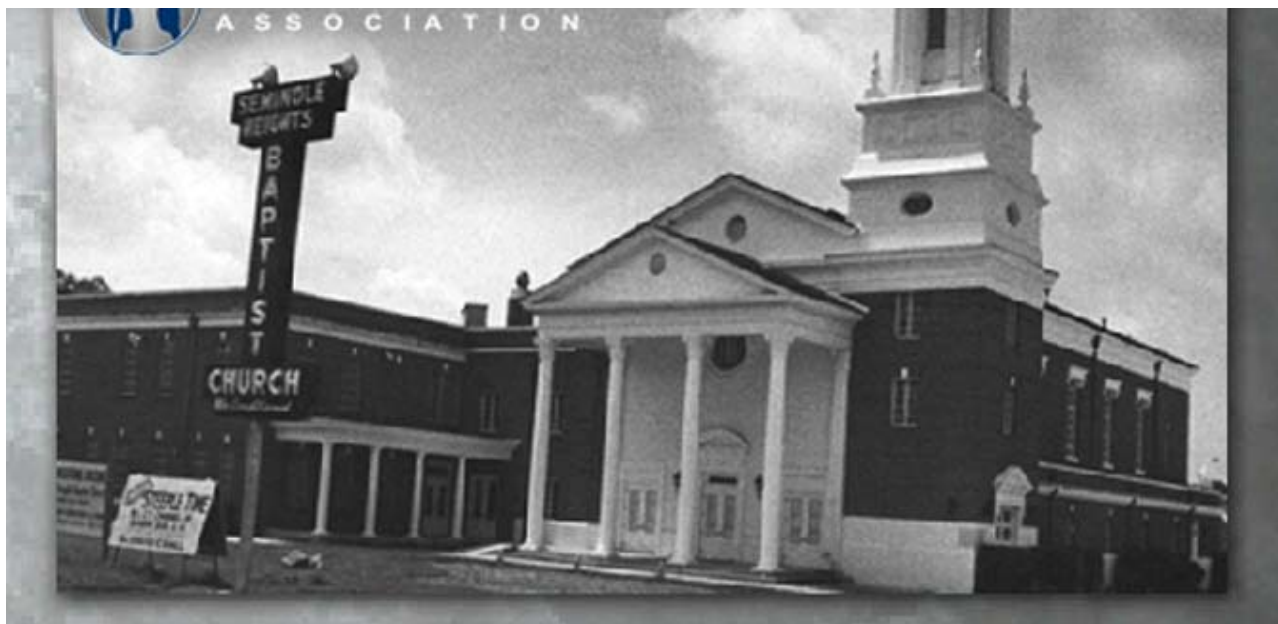
Another Incredible Evangelistic Opportunity *Revive Florida*



The Lord is providing a second great opportunity for believers in the Tampa Bay area to impact our community with the gospel. It is called *Revive Florida* and it is a ministry that simply equips and mobilizes believers to go out with already trained believers to share their faith throughout our region. *Revive Florida* will take place from October 19-27 and will be held at the Crossing Church, Mission Hill Church (formerly FBC Temple Terrace), Exciting Central Tampa Baptist Church, and other locations. Pastors and leaders are invited to the next *Revive Florida* planning luncheon. More information about this ministry and the luncheon is given below.

Please note that *Revive Florida* is not the same as the other great evangelistic outreach, *Saturate Tampa Bay*. *Saturate* is currently taking place and involves the distribution of 900,000 Jesus Film DVDs to every residence in Hillsborough, Pinellas, and south Pasco counties.

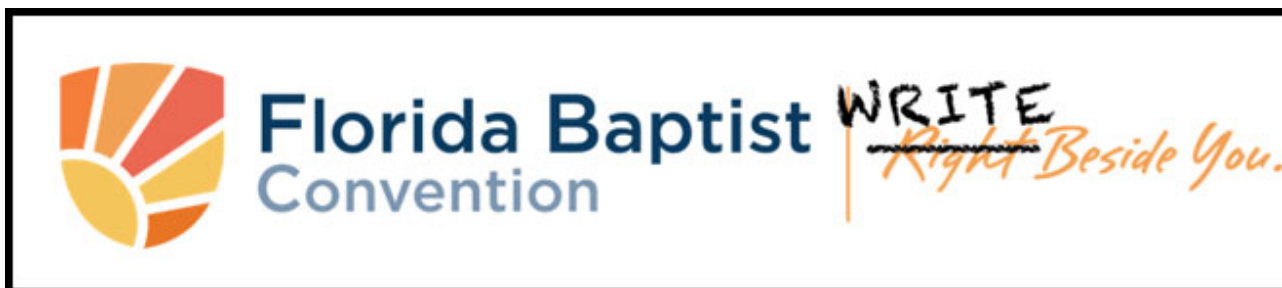

Pastors and leaders are invited to attend the next planning lunch and learn about how their church members can participate in *Revive Florida*. The actual training and outreach will take place from October 19-27.

Revive Florida uses a simple, biblical evangelistic training method that the great majority of believers can easily learn. As Jesus interacted with people throughout His earthly ministry, a pattern can be clearly observed in His life: Jesus LOVED, He LISTENED, He DISCERNED, and then He RESPONDED as He was led by the Holy Spirit.

As *Revive Florida* equips believers to share the Gospel, they will follow this pattern modeled by Jesus. Believers are trained first to LOVE the individual, then to LISTEN to him or her, to DISCERN how the Holy Spirit is working and leading, and then to RESPOND accordingly, whether that's to pray with the person, encourage them with Scripture, serve them in a tangible way, share the Gospel, or all of the above. Believers are trained to understand and articulate the Gospel in a clear and concise manner that makes them ready to give a reason for the hope they have whenever the Holy Spirit prompts them.

Focus on Baptist Collegiate Ministry (BCM)

Welcome Bags Needed: BCM Summer Ministry Project

We invite our TBBA churches to join us in coming alongside a longtime ministry in Tampa, the Baptist Collegiate Ministry (BCM) at the University of South Florida for a summer ministry project. Every August the BCM passes out "welcome bags" to the new students to introduce them to the ministry.

The BCM mission statement is.... "BUILDING RELATIONSHIPS THAT MATTER.....We are a community with a purpose. A place where college students come together to ask questions, explore who Jesus Christ is and search for something bigger than themselves...something that's beyond their busy worlds of homework, stress, work and ideas of success. From our weekly worship experience, to intramurals, to trips that take you halfway around the world, we are a passionate community that journeys through life together. " In 2017 the BCM Reached 3,225 total students -- 850 International Students - 210 students in Bible Studies - 50 involved in Missions - 10 Salvations.
