REACHING THE NEXT GENERATION



I am thankful for the many partnerships we have with Southern Baptist and other evangelical ministries. On May 16, we had two International Mission Board leaders share with our pastors how they can effectively engage their churches in missions both locally and internationally (read more about this in Recent Highlights below). On June 3, two staff members from One More Child (formerly the Florida Baptist Children's Home) shared with our pastors how their churches can provide weekend

meals to children who attend Title I schools.

One of my favorite partnerships is with the Baptist Collegiate Ministry of the University of South Florida. Nathan Schneider is the Director of the BCM and is doing a great job in leading the BCM students to impact the USF campus with the gospel. We are inviting our TBBA churches to provide "Welcome Bags" to the BCM so that they can give them to new or returning students to introduce them to their ministry.



In 2018 the BCM distributed over 1,400 bags, all collected from local churches. The bags helped the BCM connect with a number of students. One of those students found a BCM card in his dorm room after receiving a bag a couple of months prior. He decided to give the ministry a try and ended up giving his life to Jesus that night!
