PROCEEDINGS

The 110th Annual Session of the Tampa Bay Baptist Association opened at 5:00 pm October 15,2020 via zoom due to the Pandemic.

Pastor Joe Alain, Moderator and Pastor of Carrollwood Baptist Church, called the meeting to session and welcomed everyone and opened with a word of prayer.

Mike Kahn - After consulting with several DOM's, and talking with his Administration Committee, Mike decided not to meet in person for this year's Annual Celebration due to the risk of spreading the COVID virus.

Mike shared a verse of scripture from Psalm 84: 5-7. He stated that our strength is in God (individually) and in walking in partnership and relationship together.

Mike asked two pastors to share how the Association had been an encouragement to them in these difficult times.

Pastor Zelvis Applin (South Hills Church) shared with everyone what a blessing the TBBA has been to him in his journey which began back in December 2016, as he stepped out in faith from South Tampa Fellowship to become a church planter. God connected him with many people/pastors that encouraged him along the way. He stated that the TBBA doesn't just "say" they come alongside, they actually do that, through spiritual guidance and also monetarily. In a unique situation, God has allowed their church to connect with the Hispanic people in and around the Wimauma area, making an impact there through food distribution and other avenues of ministry. They have been able to minister to the people in that area since twenty-nine percent of them live under the poverty level and food distribution is a much needed ministry avenue. He thanked Mike and the TBBA for helping and encouraging him along his journey.

Pastor Joseph Hufstetler (Faith Baptist Church) is the new pastor of Faith Baptist Church and has just recently been ordained as a Southern Baptist pastor. He stated that he and his wife had grown up as Southern Baptists and desired to become part of the Southern Baptist Convention after being called to be the pastor at Faith Baptist Church. He said he had pastored for 12 years and he didn't realize until after joining the TBBA, what he had missed for those past years – brotherhood. He expressed his appreciation for the pastors and the TBBA that have helped him along in his journey.

Message by Dr. Stephen Rummage, Quail Springs Baptist Church, Oklahoma City, OK

TBBA – Mike Kahn

Mike shared that the TBBA staff is continuing to contact pastors as they have done the past several months, by making phone calls doing zoom meetings and meeting one on one. The TBBA has not been meeting as a group over the last 7 months, but did have a luncheon at Mission Hill with guest speaker Jim Cymbala in September where they were able to do social distancing. There was about 80 pastors in attendance and it was a good time of fellowship and encouragement.

Mike did not have the staff share their reports as is normally done at the Annual Celebration, due to the fact that they shared at the Executive Committee meeting via zoom in September. Mondonico Williams said his “good byes” also at the last Executive Committee meeting. Mike stated that Mondonico had been a real blessing to him and our Association, and said that we are continuing to pray for he and his family.

The TBBA staff has been working together on some strategies to continue to come alongside churches. Mike shared the strategy of “What If?” (shared screen) “What if our churches were different” – “What if we ALL” – What if we were all to bless others (lost people)? To mobilize our people to BLESS others in their neighborhoods:

B - Begin with **Prayer** (BEH – Pray, Care, Share; TBBA Training with Zoom)

L - **Listen** to others

E - **Enjoy** Others

S - **Serve** Others

S - **Share** with Others

Mike stated that the TBBA has been having racial reconciliation meetings for about four months with Southern and non-Southern Baptists pastors and leaders to establish trust with one another and move forward with racial reconciliation. We are striving to build a partnership to work together towards social justice because of the gospel.

The TBBA plans on having regional roundtables with pastors once a month for opportunities to share with what seems to be working for others in their churches.

Story

Mike called Paul Purvis to share what it has meant to him to partner together with the TBBA especially in this difficult year. Pastor Paul shared that the most significant area of partnership is the ministry of prayer. He said he was thankful for the pastors in our Association who have come together monthly in the ministry of prayer. He encouraged everyone not to give up in times of deep stress (as we are going through now) and reminded them that they are walking together with other brothers that all need each other. He prayed for them to be protected and continue to be used for His glory.

Business – Mike Kahn

(Mike shared many of the same things he had shared at the Executive Committee meeting in September)

Stewardship Committee (screen shared) Pastor JJ Johnson had an emergency so Mike presented the 2021 budget from the Stewardship Committee.

During the pandemic, giving from churches was good but it was down about \$20,000 through August. Because the pandemic is projected to be a major problem throughout most of the rest of this year, the proposed 2021 budget has been cut in anticipation of decreased church giving.

Comments for Association Budget:

The TBBA is lowering the budget by \$40,000.

Personnel – lowered by \$10,000 (This is due to no raises being given and the deletion (possibly temporary) of one part-time position).

Reimbursements - \$7,000 less (Reimbursements for gas mileage and meals to our TBBA pastoral staff since the pandemic in March, 2020 and the 2021 budget will be cut by \$7,000 in the reimbursements line item).

We received a \$7,400 reimbursement check from an insurance company for an overpayment in 2013 for Workers' Compensation insurance. We used the money to replace the sixth and final AC unit in our office building. Without this reimbursement check we would have been unable to replace the AC unit in 2020 and would have had to do it in 2021. This enables us to lower our Maintenance/Equipment line item by \$8,000 for next year.

In 2020 we received \$25,000 from the Tampa Bay Baptist Foundation and these dollars have been and are being used to assist a church with the quality of streaming of their Sunday services, anonymously helping a pastor and his family that is in need, providing food for the Jim Cymbala luncheon, partial funding the Pastors' Christmas Party and the church planters' Christmas party, and more.

Conference Center - \$17,000 (lowered)

In 2020, most of the scheduled summer camps cancelled due to the pandemic. This resulted in an enormous loss of income and yet because we did not replace the former directors, Eric and Sandra Brown, or hire a kitchen director, our expenses were also greatly reduced. Our new director, Bill Stump, has done a great job leading the Conference Center through these difficult days. We have had five great years of profit of about \$40,000-50,000 per year so our reserves enable us to weather the pandemic in good shape.

Stewardship Committee Recommendations: Pastor JJ Johnson (Mike read since Pastor JJ wasn't able to be at the Annual Celebration.

Moderator: Since this recommendation comes from a standing committee of the TBBA, no additional motion is required.” Since there were no questions, all were in favor and the 2021 Budget was approved.

Nominating Committee Recommendations: Pastor Dan Reid

Pastor Joe Alain moves from Moderator to Administrative Committee 2020-2023

Credentials Committee

Pastor Chip Luter and Pastor Charles White were appointed to the Credentials Committee for 2020-2023.

Stewardship Committee

Pastor Daniel Butson was appointed to the Stewardship Committee for 2020-2023

Since these recommendation comes from a standing committee of the TBBA, no additional motion is required. Since there were no questions, all were in favor of approving the recommendations to the various committees.

Credentials Recommendation – Bobby Patton (had an emergency at his church so Mike presented the recommendations)

As a matter of information only

The Credentials Committee members received and reviewed the Articles of Incorporation, the church budgets, and the Bylaws of Global Refuge Community Church and New Macedonia Missionary Baptist Church. The Credentials Committee met with Pastor Joe Germain of Global Refuge Community Church and pastor Paul Buster of New Macedonia Missionary Baptist Church and asked them many questions pertaining to doctrine and church polity. In keeping with the TBBA Constitution, Global Refuge Community Church will have Pastor Daniel Butson and Fishhawk Fellowship Church as their sponsoring church. New Macedonia Missionary Baptist Church will have Pastor Greg Robinson and Revelation Community Missionary Baptist church as their sponsoring church. The Credentials committee recommended at our September 21, 2020 Executive Committee meeting that these two churches be received into full fellowship with our association at the 2021 Annual Celebration in accordance with the TBBA Constitution and the recommendation was affirmed by a positive vote.

Moderator – This is a matter of information only and does not require a vote until our 2021 Annual Celebration

The Director of Missions presented a letter from Richland Baptist Church in Zephyrhills to the Credentials Committee at their August 25, 2020 meeting. The letter stated that Richland Baptist Church desires to withdraw from the Tampa Bay Baptist Association and rejoin the Pasco Baptist Association solely due to the location of their church being in southeast Pasco County. The Credentials Committee recommends that Richland Baptist Church's request to withdraw from the Tampa Bay Baptist Association be accepted. In adherence with the TBBA Constitution, this request will be communicated, but not voted on, at the October 11 Annual Celebration.

Moderator – This is a matter of information only and does not require a vote, but we rejoice together that Richland Baptist Church withdraws from our Association so that they can actively participate in the Pasco Baptist Association.

Bobby Patton: (Mike Kahn in Bobby's absence)

During our September 16, 2019 Executive Committee Meeting, Living Faith Bible Fellowship (Pastor Darryl Williamson) and No Greater Love Baptist Church (Pastor Larry Mouton) were approved to be accepted into the Tampa Bay Baptist Association at our October 11, 2020 Annual Celebration (today). Our Constitution states, "Upon approval of the Credentials Committee and the Executive Committee, said congregation will then be received at the next Annual Celebration when their request will be reviewed again for full acceptance."

Moderator:

Since this recommendation comes from a standing committee of the TBBA from 2019, no additional motion is required. Since there were no questions or comments, all were in favor of bringing both these churches into our Association. Motion carried and these churches are now accepted formally into the TBBA Association. Mike welcomed these churches into our Association.

Pastor Larry Mouton (No Greater Love) expressed his appreciation and gratitude for the guidance and fellowship he has received from the TBBA and Jeffrey Singletary (Florida Baptist Convention) and he also thanked Pastor Phil Nason (Causeway Baptist Church) for his generosity in allowing his church to meet at their facility.

Mike acknowledged Pastor Paul Buster (New Macedonia MB Church) and Pastor Joe Germaine (Global Refuge Community Church), which were recommended and voted on that they be received into our watch care for a year; however, this will not be official until next year.

Mike asked Nathan Schneider to share regarding his new leadership position as Lead Catalyst for Next Gen Ministry of the FBC. Mike congratulated him on his new position and expressed to him what a great job he had done at the BCM at the University of South Florida. Nathan said he has been transitioning for about three weeks and they are actively looking for his replacement at the USF campus. He expressed his appreciation to Mike and all the pastors and leaders that have helped him in the USF ministry.

Mike thanked Jeffrey Singletary and the FBC for all their help to the TBBA and many other ministries in the Tampa Bay area.

Mike introduced Bill Stump as the new director of the Tampa Bay Baptist Conference Center and expressed his thanks to Bill for a job well done. Bill has done a great job of keeping expenses down and keeping the Conference Center going during this difficult time.

Nomination for Moderator-Elect – Pastor Dan Reid

Pastor Dan Reid of Journey Church made his nomination for Moderator-Elect to be Pastor Jeff Knight. There was a second and since there were no other nominations, all were in favor and Pastor Jeff Knight is our new Moderator-Elect from 2020-2021.

Mike thanked Moderator Joe Alain for his service to the Tampa Bay Baptist Association and informed everyone that he would be giving Joe a plaque in the near future (due to this being a Zoom meeting).

Mike asked Pastor Dan Reid, our Moderator to close with a word of prayer.

Before being dismissed, Mike reminded everyone that our 2021 Annual Celebration would be at the First Baptist Church of Tampa on Sunday, October 17, 2021 @5pm with Pastor Erik Cummings (President of FBC) as our guest speaker.

This concluded our 2020 Annual Celebration.

DIRECTOR OF MISSIONS REPORT - Mike Kahn

Encouraging and Equipping Pastors, Planters, Leaders

Pastors and leaders were encouraged and equipped in many different ways this past year, although many training opportunities had to be cancelled due to the Corona Virus. Some of the highlights are shown below.

- Annual Pastors & Wives Christmas Party – About 90 Pastors and wives attended the annual Christmas party on December 2, 2019 at the Puelo Barn in Lutz and enjoyed a wonderful meal, great fellowship, and more.

- *Who's Your One?* Evangelism Rally

Approximately 400 pastors and leaders from the region attended NAMB's *Who's Your One?* Evangelism Rally on January 9 -10, 2020 at Calvary Baptist Church in Clearwater. Dr. Johnny Hunt, Dr. Steve Gaines, and Dr. Stephen Rummage all spoke about personal evangelism and the need for every believer to ask the Lord who their one person is that they should focus on for the sake of the gospel.

- *Bless Every Home* Prayer Ministry – The TBBA staff has recognized that the BEH prayer ministry could be an incredible resource and tool for churches to use to mobilize their members to pray for, care about, and share the gospel with lost people they know. After the BEH creator, Chris Cooper spoke at a January 13, 2020 TBBA luncheon, it became apparent that many pastors were convinced of the need for this ministry. However, because it is somewhat complicated they have not been very successful in implementing this strategy. So, the TBBA staff took the time to more fully understanding the ministry so that they can train pastors to effectively mobilize their members to pray, care, and share. A BEH tutorial was created to assist pastors in explaining this great strategy. The ongoing promotion of this ministry is occurring through Zoom meetings with one pastor at a time and we will continue to promote this ministry until every home is repeatedly prayed for by name by a Christ-follower.

- Annual Pastors Prayer Summit – The Prayer Summit took place at Day Spring Retreat Center in Parrish, Florida from January 27-29, 2020 and was attended by about 30 pastors and leaders from various evangelical churches, including eight TBBA pastors. This annual event is continuing to encourage and equip pastors to lead their churches to be stronger in prayer and it has helped to increase the number of TBBA pastors who gather together to pray on the first Wednesday or Thursday of each month.

- *All for One* Lifestyle Evangelism training

The lifestyle evangelism training curriculum called *All for One* was highlighted at the October 20, 2019 Annual celebration. It was featured for about 20 minutes at the Florida Baptist Convention's Central Florida Regional Evangelism Conference at FBC New Port Richey on February 23 2020. It was taught as a Breakout Session to over 50 pastors and leaders at the Florida Baptist Convention's Sharper Conference at Mission Hills Church on February 27, 2020. It was scheduled to be taught and then piloted by a few TBBA churches on April 17-18, 2020. It

was scheduled to be featured at the Florida Baptist Convention's Central Florida Regional Evangelism Conference in Orlando in April, 2020 and at the Ridge Baptist Association in April, 2020 but these April events were cancelled due to COVID-19.

- *Wildworks* Training at Florida Baptist Convention

Mike attended a two-day training event at the Florida Baptist Convention on March 2-3, 2020 to equip him and other attendees to help other associations that are in need of being strengthened and restored.

A March 24, 2020 *Lifeway Generosity* Training event, a May 2 *Every Home for Christ* training event, and the Annual Pastors & Wives Retreat at Innisbrook Resort were all cancelled due to the Corona Virus.

Pastors' Prayer Gatherings

TBBA pastors continued to gather once a month in various parts of our county to cry out to the Lord in repentance and to ask Him for personal revival, church-wide revival, and to send a great spiritual awakening in our country. Even after the COVID outbreak, pastors continued to pray monthly over Zoom. We started praying back in person on June 4, 2020 and will continue to do so.

We pray at the three locations listed below:

Various churches – Elbert Nasworthy

Southside Baptist Church Brandon – Dan Reid

Al Lopez Park – Pablo Urbay (Spanish)

Ministry during the Corona Virus

Everyone's Job Responsibilities drastically changed in mid-March, 2020 when the pandemic changed everything, including church and associational ministries. Our TBBA pastoral staff met in late March to discuss our best course of action. Shortly thereafter we all realized that the virus was very serious and that pastors, staff, and churches would need help in a way not seen before.

We divided up all of our churches between the DOM, Lielson Penido, Robert Beckman, and Mondonico Williams. All pastors were assigned a significant number of pastors to contact and care for on a daily basis throughout the months of April – June. An Excel spreadsheet was developed so that the TBBA staff could record a brief summary of their interactions or attempted interactions with these pastors. We agreed that we should focus on helping with:

- changes in worship gatherings
- streaming of services
- Zoom small groups
- online giving
- considering the Cares Act
- wearing of masks
- Regathering for worship
- and more

Many Zoom meetings were scheduled with groups of TBBA pastors and with individual pastors to discuss the above topics. Many phone calls were made to individual pastors also.

During the pandemic we were prompted to take a fresh look at evangelism training and try to come up with simpler training ways to help pastors train and mobilize their members to be on mission. We took different parts of the *All for One* curriculum, mentioned earlier in this report, and broke them into different stand-alone units.

All of the TBBA team had great input during weekly discussions on simplified evangelism training. We developed a **WHAT IF?** Great Commission strategy to prayerfully help our churches mobilize tens of thousands of their members for evangelism in the near future. This compelling **What If?** question is broken down into the following practical actions. **What If we all were to B.L.E.S.S. others?**

- B** **B**egin with Prayer (Bless Every Home neighborhood prayer ministry)
- L** **L**isten to Others
- E** **E**njoy Others
- S** **S**erve Others
- S** **S**hare with Others (Our story, Gospel story)

Florida Baptist Convention

Mike served as Vice-Chairman on the Florida Baptist Convention State Board of Missions with the Administrative Committees.

Revitalizations & More

Temple Crest Baptist Church gave their properties to the Tampa Bay Baptist Holdings Company which then sold the properties at a greatly reduced price to New Victory Baptist Church. Seminole Heights Baptist Church is in the process of selling their property and building and plans to relocate their congregation to another church that is located within a few miles of their current location. This will better enable SHBC to focus on ministering to the community instead of having to pour all of their resources into repairing their large building. Three other churches are in the process of possibly giving or selling their properties to another TBBA church.

Revision to TBBA Constitution

The following pastors were selected to serve on a TBBA Constitution revision committee (Elbert Nasworthy – Chairman, Dan Reid, Tim Encinosa, Joe Alain, Michael Miller, Mike Kahn). The committee met three times before the COVID-19 breakout and will resume meeting again in the near future.

Mondonico Williams

Dr. Mondonico Williams temporarily joined the TBBA staff in late November, 2019 for up to one year. He has been financially supported by the Florida Baptist Convention and Idlewild Baptist Church. Mondonico was initially assigned to work with Mike Kahn on the *All for One* lifestyle evangelism curriculum, other evangelism strategies, Bless Every Home neighborhood prayer ministry, and assisting African American pastors and churches. However, everything changed due to the March pandemic and his assignments were adjusted as indicated in the above section, **Ministry during the Corona Virus**. Mondonico has done a great job and will be missed by the TBBA staff and the pastors he has encouraged and helped.

Church Planting Catalyst Report – Robert Beckman

The Church Planting Catalyst serves in concert with the DOM to assist our churches in planning, developing leaders, and planting new churches.

Language Ministry Catalyst Report – Lielson Penido

The Language Ministry Catalyst serves in concert with the DOM to assist our ethnic churches and church plants (non English speaking) in all phases of ministry.

Hispanic Men's Conference - Due to the impact of the global pandemic, the 2019 Hispanic Men's Conference was canceled.

Hispanic Pastors' and Wives' Meeting - In the beginning of 2020 we had one meeting before we could no longer meet due to the COVID-19. Our meetings and gatherings have been on line only. We stopped meeting for our once a month (first Wednesday) prayer and fellowship at Al Lopez Park due to COVID but now have started back as of September. Attendance is still picking up after almost 6 months. We invite more pastors to join us every month.

Leadership Training - Even though the pandemic has forced us to do social distancing, due to technology we have been having virtual training sessions using Zoom as our platform. Since March, we have been able to have approximately once a month virtual training using leaders from many parts of the globe.

ESSER Spanish Biblical Institute - Since the start of the Biblical Institute "ESSER" in September of 2017, starting with more than 68 students, we had our first graduation on January 25, 2020. Many students already are in contact with local and international seminaries to continue their studies. We are so honored and blessed to see what God has done in our midst. In February 2020, we started our second group of students with classes in three different campuses in the Tampa Bay area. In March, we were able to finish our 4 weeks' class virtually due to COVID-19. On August 26, we returned to our classes virtually and we plan to finish 2020 with the same virtual classes. We hope to return in person in 2021.

ADMINISTRATIVE COMMITTEE REPORT

The Administrative Committee received Associational staff performance reviews in the mail from the Executive Director of Missions. The committee then met once with the Executive Director of Missions to discuss the performance reviews and to talk about Personnel issues. Due to decreased giving from churches because of the pandemic, Mike informed the members that he was proposing a reduction in personnel costs by \$10,300 which would be accomplished by not replacing a part-time employee who moved to Ocala. Also, there would be no raises for the TBBA staff in 2021. The committee voted in agreement with these recommendations and also met personally with the Director of Missions to give him a favorable annual evaluation.

BAPTIST COLLEGIATE MINISTRIES – BCM – Nathan Schneider, Director

To say that the events of 2020 have been unexpected is an understatement!

The BCM at USF began the 2019-2020 school year with a great work of God. Throughout the fall semester, more students were participating in worship and discipleship than in recent years. In fact, the number of discipleship groups (mentoring groups of 2-3) and the number of students participating in those groups, doubled from the previous year. As the BCM partners with local Baptist churches to make disciples at USF, it was also encouraging to see about 15 local churches actively serving at the BCM, whether that be through providing a meal, partnering in evangelism, or in actively participating in worship nights. Students from the BCM have also served local churches by serving as volunteers, filling in for leadership roles, helping at retreats, and more.

In response to the growing concern over the Corona virus, in person gatherings at the BCM were cut short during the spring semester. Immediately, worship services, Bible studies, leadership meetings, and discipleship groups transitioned to virtual events. We anticipated a return to face-to-face gatherings as we returned for the fall semester (2020). However, university guidelines are that student organizations remain virtual, at least for the beginning of the semester. These guidelines present challenges, but God has already been working through divine appointments to create greater discipleship opportunities.

CONFERENCE CENTER REPORT – Mike Kahn – (New Director, Bill Stump)

The Tampa Bay Baptist Conference Center has a new Director, Bill Stump who was promoted to this position from within the TBBCC staff. He started as the Director about the time of the pandemic so I have been spending lots of time with him to help him. He is doing a great job but we lost almost all of our 2020 summer camps due to the virus. It has been a difficult season financially but we have reduced personnel costs and experienced a greater usage of other TBBCC outdoor amenities. This has helped the TBBCC to reduce some of its losses from the cancelled summer camps.

We trust that the summer of 2021 will be another great season of summer camps and that many children and students will trust Christ as their Savior at these retreats.

FOUNDATION (TBBF) REPORT – Elbert Nasworthy, Chairman

The mission of the Foundation is to assist and support the Southern Baptist churches that are members of the Association in proclaiming the gospel of Jesus Christ in the Tampa Bay area and beyond.

In 2020, the Foundation assisted and supported our churches by generously giving the TBBA \$25,000. This amount was reduced from previous years due to the fact that there was less TBBA activity because of the pandemic. These gifts continue to be used to

- Encourage Pastors
- Equip Leaders
- Multiply churches

Some of the ways that these generous gifts were used in 2020 are as shown below:

- Assist a church with the quality of streaming of their Sunday services
- Anonymously helping a few pastors and their families that were in financial need
