BIO: Dr. Jamison L. Work has served as a pastor for more than 36 years in six churches across three states. While serving as a local pastor, Dr. Work sponsored three successful church plants, started two Christian schools,

and initiated a Church Planting and Theological Training Institute. He also has written a 40-Day Church Revitalization Prayer Guide that is broadly used across several state conventions.

The heartbeat of Work's ministry has been discipling, equipping, and mobilizing believers to embrace God's call to disciple the nations, with special emphasis on the least-reached and unreached peoples in the 10/40 Window. He has personally led mission teams or mobilized other believers to carry the Good News to approximately 30 states and more than 25 international locations.

Work's most recent congregation commissioned more than 50 people to go live on the international mission field and saw more than 100 people participate every year in short-term mission projects in the US and around the globe.
