I heard about a man who while cleaning out his desk, found a shoe-repair ticket that was ten years old. Figuring he had nothing to lose, he went to the shop and gave the ticket to the repairman, who began to search the back room for the unclaimed shoes. After several minutes, he reappeared and gave the ticket back to the man.

"What's wrong?" asked the man. "Couldn't you find my shoes?" "Oh, I found them," replied the repairmen, "and they'll be ready next Friday.

I cannot speak for you but I know at times I fail to promptly do what I know I should do. King Joash was described in 2 Chronicles 24 as one who did what was right in the sight of the Lord, and he even decided to restore the Temple of the Lord. According to verse 5, he gathered the priests and Levites and said to them, "Go to the towns of Judah and collect the money due annually from all Israel, to repair the Temple of your God. Do it now." But the Levites did not act at once.

That is interesting. The king clearly told the priests and Levites to collect the money right away but for some reason they did not do it. The chapter does not indicate why they did not obey their king. One Bible commentator wrote that "perhaps they felt that the townspeople of the outer towns would not embrace and support this work." Another commentator stated that they may have felt that they were too busy to take on such an added responsibility.

Whatever the reason for their disobedience was, it can be rightly stated that it is easy for people to dismiss doing what they know they ought to be doing. We can make excuses, blame others, or even convince ourselves that we will one day get around to doing it. But it is always best to obey our Lord right away. Has He clearly told you something you should start or stop doing? He still and often speaks to us through the preached and taught Word of God, through personal Bible reading, through small groups, through personal interactions, through circumstances, and more. Let's not be like the priests and Levites who served under King Joash. Let's obey our Lord today and everyday because there is no time like the present.
