Church Planting Story

Pastor Mark Warren (Journey Church of Wesley Chapel) shared his church planting story. Pastor Mark is a new church plant in Wesley Chapel that is now meeting in Pastor Quincey Stratford’s (Carmel Friendship Church) old location. Spanish Church Stories

Pastor Ray Sanabria – (Iglesia de Odessa)

Pastor Ray Sanabria (Iglesia de Odessa) shared his “journey” of his call to be a church planter. Pastor Ray shared that being a church planter was much different than being in the office at Idlewild as the Global Mission Pastor. He stated that God had been faithful in providing financial help through the Tampa Bay Baptist Association not to mention the relational support and encouragement he has received as well. An added blessing was that Lielson Penido has been helping with leading worship at his church.

Pastor Jaime Lopez (Bell Shoals Hispanic)

Pastor Jaime is the Hispanic pastor at Bell Shoals.

Pastor Jaime had Covid last year and had severe complications resulting in an infection in his colon and had to have a portion of his colon removed thus having to have a colostomy bag for a while. He will have it removed within the next few days.

He was thankful for the Association and all the churches, along with his home church, Bell Shoals, that supported him and the many people that prayed for him during this very difficult time. He shared that even with all that was going on in his life, God was still faithful and they have had 40 people attend the church even after Covid and have baptized 25 people.

At this time, Mike prayed for Pastor Jaime’s upcoming surgery that he would recover with no complications.

Pastor Carmelo Bacino (La Nueva Esperanza) came to the platform and Lielson presented the Tom Biles grant to him. He expressed his gratefulness for this grant through Lielson who interpreted for him.

Mike thanked Pastor Bob Block and Pastor Darren Selvidge for allowing the Celebration to be held at FBC Tampa and for the great worship service through song with Pastor Darren and the Praise Team.

Church Story

Pastor Larry Mouton (No Greater Love church) stated how much he appreciated the Association under Mike's leadership. He mentioned the many ministry opportunities presented to him through the Association and how each one helped to grow him and his congregation to further fulfill the Great Commission.

Florida Baptist Convention – Next Gen (Nathan Schneider)

Nathan Schneider is the Next Gen Catalyst with the Florida Baptist Convention and stated that 130 profession of faith decisions were made at student camp. He was excited to say, "God is saving young people!"

Mike recognized and welcomed Pastor Jeff Singletary with the FBC, and mentioned the Florida Baptist Convention Annual meeting in Lakeland – November 8-9.

Church Story

Pastor Dave Ungar (Friendship Baptist Church) gave a testimony regarding the All for One evangelism training that he has been using with his church. Pastor Dave stated that All for One is a simple, effective evangelism strategy that helps to equip believers to be lifestyle witnesses. He encouraged pastors to incorporate this training into their churches.

Message by Dr. Cummings

Business Meeting – Pastor Dan Reid, Moderator

At this time, there was a brief time of business. As Chairman of the Nominating Committee, Pastor Dan made the following recommendations:

Nominating Committee Recommendation

The Tampa Bay Baptist Association Nominating Committee has met and makes the nominations that are shown in your Book of Reports. These nominations were unanimously approved at the September 20, 2021 Executive Committee meeting. Attention was directed to the lines marked 2021-2024 under each committee to see the names of the new nominees. Our committee recommends that these nominated individuals be approved as TBBA leaders as shown in the Book of Reports.

Moderator: Pastor Dan Reid

Since this recommendation comes from a standing committee of the TBBA, no additional motion was required. Since there were no questions, all were in favor.

Pastor Dan invited Pastor Tim Encinosa (sitting in for Chairman JJ Johnson) to the platform to make his recommendation for the Stewardship Committee.

Stewardship Committee Recommendation

The Tampa Bay Baptist Association Stewardship Committee has met and recommends the approval of the proposed 2021-2022 TBBA budget that can be found in the Book of Reports. This budget was unanimously approved at the September 20, 2021 Executive Committee meeting. A

few minutes were taken to present an overview of the proposed TBBA budget. At this time, Pastor Tim gave a brief overview and a few highlights. The Stewardship Committee recommended that this 2021-22 budget be approved as show in the Book of Reports.

Moderator: Pastor Dan Reid

Since this recommendation comes from a standing committee of the TBBA, no additional motion was required. Since there were no questions for discussion, all were in favor.

At this time Pastor Bobby Patton (Credentials Committee) was invited to the platform to make his recommendations.

Credentials Committee Recommendation

The Tampa Bay Baptist Association's Credentials Committee members received and reviewed the Articles of Incorporation, the church budgets, and the Bylaws of the One Another Ministry Church. The credentials Committee met with Pastor Gedeon Augustin of the One Another Ministry Church and asked him many question pertaining to doctrine and church polity. This church is shown in your Book of Reports. One Another Ministry Church has Grace Community Church of the Suncoast Baptist Association as their sponsoring church. The Executive Committee unanimously voted on September 20, 2021 to receive this church into full fellowship with our association at the 2022 Annual Celebration when their request will be reviewed again for full acceptance.

Moderator: Pastor Dan Reid

Since this recommendation comes from a standing committee of the TBBA, no additional motion was required. Since there were no questions for discussion, all were in favor.

Bobby Patton:

An email was sent to Mike Kahn from Pastor Randy Huckabee of the First Baptist Church of Dade City requesting membership into the Tampa Bay Baptist Association. The TBBA bylaws does not address how a standing church in the SBC can come into the Association. Mike had a conversation with Pastor Randy and the DOM of the Pasco Association (since the First Baptist Church of Dade City was a member of that Association). Then Mike took the request for membership before the TBBA Credentials Committee on November 12, 2020 to discuss the request. Since FBC Dade City has been a faithful Southern Baptist church for many years and because Pastor Randy Huckabee has faithfully served in many roles in the Pasco Baptist Association and as the Recording Secretary of the Florida Baptist Convention, the Credentials Committee unanimously voted to recommend that First Baptist Dade City be received into full fellowship with the Tampa Bay Baptist Association at our Annual 2021 Celebration. This recommendation was then unanimously approved at our February 1, 2021 Executive Committee meeting.

Moderator: Pastor Dan Reid

Since this recommendation comes from a standing committee of the TBBA, no additional motion is required. Since there were no questions for discussion, all were in favor.

Bobby Patton:

During our September, 2020 Executive Committee meeting and our 2020 Annual Celebration, we voted to approve New Macedonia MB Church (Pastor Paul Buster) with Revelation Church as their sponsoring church, and we voted to approve the Global Refuge Community Church (Pastor Joseph Germain) with Fishhawk Fellowship Church as their sponsoring church. Our Constitution

states, “Upon approval of the Credentials Committee and the Executive Committee, said congregation will then be received at the next Annual Celebration when their request will be reviewed again for full acceptance.” In accordance with our Constitution, both of these churches are being presented for full acceptance tonight.

Moderator: Pastor Dan Reid

Since this recommendation comes from a standing committee of the TBBA from 2020, no additional motion is required. There were no questions for discussion and all were favor.

Bobby Patton:

In 2018, the Executive Committee, in a special called meeting, recommended that our DOM (Mike Kahn) talk with the Element Church pastors (they had a female co-pastor) to reconcile their relationship to see if Element Church might ultimately withdraw from the TBBA. Mike has talked many times over the past three years with Pastors Benjamin and Melody and the Lord has restored their relationship. The Director of Missions received an email from Element Church in Tampa stating their desire to withdraw from the Tampa Bay Baptist Association. This request was presented to the attendees at the September 20, 2021 Executive Committee meeting as a matter of information, and not for a vote. Based on the previous recommendation from the Executive Committee in 2018, it is recommended that the Element Church’s’ request to withdraw from the Tampa Bay Baptist Association be accepted. In adherence with the TBBA Constitution, this request is being communicated to you tonight without a need for a vote.

Nominations for Moderator- Elect Pastor Randy Huckabee

Pastor Randy Huckabee of FBC Dade City made his nomination for Moderator-Elect to be Pastor Carl Ellison (Wiregrass Church). He highly recommended Pastor Carl Ellison as the Moderator-Elect. There was a second to the nomination and since there were no other nominations, all were in favor of Pastor Carl Ellison becoming the Moderator-Elect for 2021-22.

Mike thanked Moderator Pastor Dan Reid for his service to the Tampa Bay Baptist Association.

Mike asked Pastor Carl Ellison, our Moderator Elect, to close with a word of prayer.
This concluded our 2021 Annual Celebration.

DIRECTOR OF MISSIONS REPORT - Mike Kahn

Encouraging and Equipping Pastors, Planters, Leaders

The past 19 months of COVID have been very hard on all of our pastors and the TBBA staff. Pastors and leaders were encouraged and equipped in many different ways this past year, although many training opportunities had to be cancelled due to the Corona Virus.

A number of churches that were struggling prior to COVID, experienced extreme hardship during COVID. Much time was spent in attempting to individually advise pastors and leaders in the best decisions they could make for the glory of God and for the sake of their churches. Some of these situations are mentioned below:

Difficult church situations and results

- Causeway BC gifted their properties and assets to No Greater Love BC.
- Fellowship BC in Valrico voted to have Fishhawk Fellowship revitalize them.
- Wellswood BC sold their property to a Christian owned company so that the Wellswood sanctuary will be used as a future church planting “incubator”.
- Faith BC had ongoing conflict with some former leaders and we helped them to completely rewrite their Constitution & Bylaws and resolve the conflict. We also advised them about the handling of serious building problems, the sale of their buildings, and continue to talk to Pastor Joseph about a future relocation of the church.
- Tampa Shores Community had a number of meetings with a few deacons about viable options due to declining attendance and giving; still working closely with them.
- Journey Church Brandon (continued to assist and encourage Pastor Dan during the three years that it took for Tropical Acres BC to be gifted to Journey Church Brandon).
- Palm Ave BC (many meetings with Pastor Robby and a leadership couple to discuss options for revitalizing Palm Avenue; meetings are still ongoing)
- FBC Brandon (often talked with and met with Pastor David Durham to provide counsel and support through their 22 months of not having a senior pastor).
- Element Church – Mike had many conference calls with their pastors throughout the year that culminated in a meeting with Element elders and TBBA task force leaders to dialogue about their female pastor situation. They have voted to withdraw from the TBBA.

Various Events

- We cancelled our 2020 Annual Pastors & Wives Christmas party at the Puleos due to COVID. However, Lielson, Robert, and Mike personally delivered or mailed about 75 Outback gift cards to pastors in early December.

- We started back with hosting Pastors’ Forums on Zoom in January, 2021. They were designed to help us check up on the pastors and to see how their churches were doing. Jeffery Singletary (Florida Baptist Convention) also partnered together with us to offer ongoing

Zoom meetings during the early part of 2021 for the same purpose. The meetings were usually attended by 10 - 25 pastors.

Pastors' Prayer Gatherings

TBBA pastors continued to gather in person, once a month in various parts of our county to cry out to the Lord in repentance and to ask Him for personal revival, church-wide revival, and to send a great spiritual awakening in our country. We prayed at the three locations listed below:

- Various churches – Elbert Nasworthy
 - Southside Baptist Church Brandon – Dan Reid
 - Various churches – Eloy Rodriguez (Spanish)
- Annual Pastors Prayer Summit – The Prayer Summit took place at Day Spring Retreat Center in Parrish, Florida from February 8-10, 2021 and was attended by about 40 pastors and leaders from various evangelical churches, including a number of TBBA pastors. This annual event is continuing to encourage and equip pastors to lead their churches to be stronger in prayer and it has helped to increase the number of TBBA pastors who gather together to pray on the first Thursday or Saturday of each month.
- Dr. Jamie Works with IMB - On April 6, 2021 we hosted a Zoom meeting with Dr. Jamie Works of the IMB to share about IMB strategies to partner with associations and churches. We learned that in 2021, each of the 3,600 IMB missionaries would be making personal contact with 20 different SBC churches. The desire is for every church to have a personal relationship and partnership with one or more IMB missionaries.
- Pastor Jim Cymbala shared in person on April 23, 2021 with about 30 pastors and their wives (60 people total) about recharging their spiritual batteries during the pandemic.
- We held our 2021 annual Pastors & Wives Retreat at Innisbrook from June 24-26 with a smaller number (15 couples) in attendance so that social distancing could be maintained. Darin Saley once again was the speaker.
- In July, 2021 we took a total of 34 pastors and guests to a free Rays baseball game. Each person received a Rays cap and money for lunch and parking. Due to Hurricane Elsa the Rays played a double header and won both games.

Training

- Ramsey + - Throughout November of 2020 we used Zoom to partner with the Dave Ramsey Ministries to offer an incredible package of Ramsey ministries for a very low price. A number of TBBA churches took advantage of this offering.
- Knock & Pray - In January, 2021 we started a “Knock & Pray” strategy for churches to Zoom train their lay people to wear masks, go out into their church neighborhood, knock on the doors of their church neighbors, and ask them how they could pray for them during the

pandemic. Numerous Zoom trainings took place during January – March, and seven churches participated.

- *Bless Every Home* Prayer Ministry - The TBBA staff has continued to individually promote this incredible neighborhood prayer ministry to pastors and leaders through one-on-one in person and Zoom meetings. As a result, the following TBBA churches (and a few other non-SBC churches we know of) are engaged in this prayer and evangelism ministry to some extent:

We will continue to promote this ministry until every home is repeatedly prayed for by name by a Christ-follower.

- *All for One* Lifestyle Evangelism training - At the May 17, 2021 Executive Committee meeting we distributed a free *All for One* Trainee Workbook and Trainer Guide to each attendee. I then briefly explained the *All for One* lifestyle evangelism ministry that the Lord led me to complete just prior to the COVID outbreak in March of 2020.

All for One was then featured in the June, 2021 e-News. A June Constant Contact highlighting this ministry was also sent to every TBBA pastor later in June. Trainee Workbooks and Trainer Guides were mailed to pastors who did not attend the Executive Committee meeting. As a result, there has been some interest in this training ministry.

A 10-minute video was created to explain some of the unique features of *All for One*. Some of these features are:

- Emphasis on lifestyle evangelism (everyday) rather than programmatic evangelism (*once a week*)
- Emphasis on Spirit-empowered living being the foundation for lifestyle evangelism.
- Training takes place in “triad huddles” (*1 trainer with 3 trainees*) anytime & anywhere
- Relational group evangelism in homes or at the office
- New believer follow-up

Five 2-hour meetings (Deeper Dives) have been held for pastors and leaders (17 people attended) so that they can more fully understand the training ministry. A Deeper Dive will be offered once a month for as long as pastors and leaders choose to attend them. Darby

Community Church leaders have attended an 8-hour Intensive training so that they can launch the ministry in the fall. Friendship Baptist Church leaders attended two 4-hour Intensive Trainings so that they can launch in the fall also. Belmont Baptist Church has scheduled their eight-hour intensive training so that they can launch early next year. Other churches have shown interest in using this ministry to have an ongoing training mechanism for lifestyle evangelism.

A Generosity Training event was held in the evening on June 10, 2021 at the TBBA offices. It was led by Pastor Rob Taylor of Idlewild.

- Marriage Discipleship Training – Gio Llerena and Roland Martinez taught church leader couples the 2 *Becoming 1* marriage ministry on July 17, 2021 so that the couples can start and multiply this small group marriage discipling at their churches.

- A Preaching Conference was led by Pastor Stephen Rummage at the Mission Hill Lake Carroll campus on August 20-21. There were 32 preachers in attendance.

- About 80 pastors and wives from the TBBA and other churches attended a Refresh Date Night with Johnny Hunt at the Temple Terrace Golf and Country Club on September 30. It was a great time of encouragement and fellowship for everyone and NAMB provided free back packs with a number of Johnny Hunt books.

Iglesia Bautista Restauracion – Pastor Lester Acosta has begun a new Spanish-speaking church gathering at: 6403 Theresa St., Tampa, FL 33615

Comunidad Cristiana de Tampa – Pastor Carlos Diaz Rivera has begun a new Spanish-speaking church gathering at: 300 E. Sligh Ave, Tampa, FL 33604

New Churches Credentialed from October, 2020 – September, 2021

LANGUAGE MINISTRY CATALYST REPORT – Lielson Penido

The Language Ministry Catalyst serves in concert with the DOM to assist our ethnic churches and church plants (non English speaking) in all phases of ministry.

Keystone Korean Baptist Church

I connected with Pastor Kim Jung from Korean Baptist Church meeting several times to fellowship and encourage him. I was able to introduce Pastor Jung to Word of Life ministries, which is a ministry that does a great work with youth. Word of Life has been doing once a month Bible clubs training young Koreans in how to reach their generations for Christ.

Hispanic Men's Conference

Because of the pandemic, we haven't been able to meet in person since 2020. However, this year we decided to do a one-day retreat instead of two days. On June 12 we had our Hispanic Men's retreat at the Tampa Bay Baptist Conference center with 98 men participating. Our special guest was pastor Roney Paz from Ocala. We also had 3 panelist participate from our TBBA - Pastor Eloy Rodriguez (Idlewild Español), Pastor Jaime Lopez (Bell Shoals Español) and Pastor Lielson Penido (TBBA).

Monthly Prayer Meeting Pastors' and Wives' Meeting

The beginning of 2021, we resumed our prayer meetings every month. We took the opportunity to change some of the format, location, and dates that we previously had done. We meet every first Saturday of the month at 9am in different locations when possible. New pastors have been joining us, meeting with a good solid core group since we changed our day and format. Pr. Eloy has been the one in charge of organizing and arranging the location for our monthly meetings.

Keeping in touch with pastors

Slowly I have been able to connect with pastors more in person than via zoom, text or phone call. I have been visiting at least once a month with our language churches.

ESSER Spanish Biblical Institute

In the midst of the pandemic, ESSER continues to be strong. Since our first graduation back in 2017, many former ESSER students are continuing their theological studies. We are so honored and blessed to see what God has done in our midst. Since our second cohort group

of students started back in February 2020, we have two different campuses in the Tampa Bay area. One in Brandon and one in Lutz. Our classes continue to be virtual currently with 17 faithful students from 5 different churches. We hope to return in person in 2022.

Church Planting

Like it has been said, “Don’t spread germs, spread the Word”. In other words, we continue to spread the gospel by helping start new churches in our area. God continues to bless our efforts. In just 9 months since Jan 2021, we helped start 2 Spanish churches: La Iglesia de Odessa (LIDO) – Pr. Ray Sanabria meeting at Church of Odessa. Iglesia Bautista Restauración – Pr. Lester Acosta meeting at Rocky Creek Baptist Church. One Spanish church was born out of our partner church, Idlewild en Español, Comunidad Cristiana de Tampa – Pr. Carlos Diaz Rivera. This makes a total of 3 Spanish churches being planted in 2021. We currently have two other language churches (one Portuguese and one Spanish) slated to start next year.



ADMINISTRATIVE COMMITTEE REPORT

The Administrative Committee received Associational staff performance reviews in the mail from the Executive Director of Missions. The committee then met once with the Executive Director of Missions to discuss the performance reviews and to talk about Personnel issues. The committee also met personally with the Director of Missions to give him his annual evaluation, which was favorable. Based on the Director of Missions’ recommendation, the Administrative Committee recommended to the Stewardship committee that 1% or 2% raises be provided for the TBBA staff and a \$3,000 and \$1,000 raise be given to the two Tampa Bay Baptist Conference Center staff members.



BAPTIST COLLEGIATE MINISTRIES – BCM – Jay Sanders, Director

Our BCM Leadership kicked off 2021 convinced that COVID cannot kill the mission of God at USF. Our small groups and LIVE MIDWEEK collegiate services remained consistent online through the Spring, 2021 semester. There were a faithful number of students committed and deeply engaged in our weekly BCM programming. Although we were socially distanced, through technology we were able to remain spiritually unified.

God has been on the move at USF in the Fall of 2021. We had an overwhelming turnout at our WEEK OF WELCOME EVENTS. These events allowed us to make contact with hundreds of new Freshmen.

At our first service this Fall, 15 students made a profession of faith and 17 students recommitted to their Christian walk. There hasn’t been a service since then that we haven’t seen students make decisions for Christ. 30 students have indicated their decision to follow Christ this Fall, and 20 have recommitted their lives to Christ. Each one is being personally followed up with by our leadership team.

Close to 60 of our students are engaged in a weekly BCM small group, and many are committed to a local Baptist church. Many of them have gone beyond being a weekly attender, and have rolled up their sleeves and become servants in their local church.

We are hopeful that by the time students graduate, they will have four spiritual disciplines rooted in their life. Those disciplines are: spending time with God daily, spending time with others consistently, knowing and using their gifts in their local church, and knowing how to boldly share their faith.

The BCM couldn't exist without the steady and strong support of local Baptist churches. The BCM is simply an extension of the local church. We will never forget that. I believe together we will be able to see more College students in Tampa reached, developed, and sent out for the glory of God.



CONFERENCE CENTER REPORT – Bill Stump, Director

Although we lost almost all of our 2020 summer camps due to the Corona Virus, many summer camps were held in 2021. There were six large camps and two sets of two mini camps. The Lord greatly blessed and we have heard from the participating churches that there were 20 professions of faith in Christ, 20 rededications, and 13 baptisms as a result of these camps.



FOUNDATION (TBBF) REPORT – Elbert Nasworthy, Chairman

The mission of the Foundation is to assist and support the Southern Baptist churches that are members of the Association in proclaiming the gospel of Jesus Christ in the Tampa Bay area and beyond.

In 2021 the Foundation assisted and supported our churches by generously giving the TBBA \$25,000. This amount was the same as in 2020, but it was reduced from previous years due to the fact that there was less TBBA activity because of the pandemic. These gifts continue to be used to

- Encourage Pastors
- Equip Leaders
- Multiply churches

Some of the ways that these generous gifts were used in 2021 are as shown below:

- Funding for the April 23, 2021 Jim Cymbala Refresh Pastors and Wives date night at Mission Hills Church
- Partial funding for the Pastors & Wives Retreat at the Palm Harbor Innisbrook Resort from June 24-26, 2021. Fifteen couples attended.
- Partial funding for the “Pastors +1” Tampa Bay Rays double-header on July 7, 2021. It was attended by 34 pastors and guests.
- Funding for the Marriage Discipleship Training that was led by Gio Llerena and Roland Martinez. Church leader couples were trained in the *2 Becoming 1* marriage ministry on July 17, 2021.

- Partial funding for the TBBA Preaching Conference that was led by Pastor Stephen Rummage at the Mission Hill Lake Carroll campus on August 20-21, 2021. There were 32 preachers in attendance.
- Funding for the September 30, 2021 Pastors & Wives Date Night with Johnny Hunt at the Temple Terrace Golf and Country Club. 80 pastors and wives attended.

Additionally, the Foundation gave a \$5,000 designated grant to the TBBA to pay for the printing of materials and training costs for the All for One Lifestyle Evangelism ministry. This has enabled the TBBA to pay for the printing of 100 Trainee Workbooks and 100 Trainer Guides. The remaining money will be used to print more Workbooks and Guides, as needed.

Westshore Baptist Church and First Baptist Church Port Tampa received grants from the Annual Project Jerusalem fund that is provided through the Foundation.

The Foundation's \$2,500 Annual Tom Biles award was given to La Nueva Esperanza.

The TBBF also gave generous grants to a few churches that had purchased, or were given, older church properties and buildings. These churches used the grants to help renovate these older buildings so that effective gospel work could take place at these locations.
