PROCEEDINGS

The 112th Annual Session of the Tampa Bay Baptist Association opened at 5:00 pm October 16, 2022 at South Tampa Fellowship.

Pastor JJ Johnson, pastor of South Tampa Fellowship, welcomed everyone and opened with a word of prayer.

Pastor and Moderator Elect, Carl Ellison, filling in for Pastor Dan Reid, (Moderator), called the meeting to Session of the Tampa Bay Baptist Association. Pastor Carl stated that the Celebration would be first then the business of the TBBA would follow. At this time, Pastor David Bancroft was introduced as the worship leader of South Tampa Fellowship.

Church Planting Catalyst Report – Robert Beckman

Robert highlighted two church plants from the Book of Reports.

Pastor John Antonucci (The Church at Channelside) and Pastor James Blewett (Extraordinary Church) to share their stories.

Pastor John Antonucci shared that they have been meeting about two months and have about 50 - 60 people attending. He shared how God has blessed them with people that are walking to church and he mentioned one particular couple that came to the church and had never had a relationship with Jesus. They found that relationship with Jesus, were baptised and are now helping with growing the church. He stated that he felt blessed that God is letting him see how He is growing "His" church. He thanked the TBBA and the family of associational churches for their support both prayerfully and financially that has helped them as a church plant.

Pastor James Blewett (Extraordinary Church). He shared that he had grown up in the Tampa area and was saved under the leadership of Pastor JJ Johnson who was then the Youth Pastor. Pastor James dedicated 20 years of his life to being a Youth Pastor. After COVID, he and his wife decided that they needed to get to know their neighbors since everything had more or less shut down because of COVID. They started a Bible study at Maple Street Biscuit Company that still goes on today every Tuesday night. After talking with Pastor JJ and praying about it, they felt the Lord was telling them to plant a church in the Brandon area. They started their church plant on January 23, 2022 with people mostly from their neighborhood. They have baptized six people since they began and will be starting a Hispanic church soon. He thanked the TBBA for their investment in his life.

Language Ministry Catalyst Report – Lielson Penido

Highlights from the Book of Reports/ESSER Report

Lielson stated that in the Tampa Bay area there are 3.22 million people and 28-29 % speak different languages which would be 960,000 that speak another language other than English. This increases the need for different language churches to spread the gospel. There are a lot of different people groups moving to the Tampa Bay area that need to hear the gospel in their language.

Lielson has been working with the Chin Community Church of Tampa trying to help them to relocate to another building as they are outgrowing their present one.

Lielson has also been working with a young man, Pastor Lesky, who is now being trained with NAMB and will soon be starting a new Spanish church in the Brandon area.

Central Baptist Church of Brandon is another church that is starting a Spanish church in Brandon as well.

Lielson stated that he had started a Portuguese speaking church back in February and they are currently meeting at First Baptist Church of Riverview. There are no Brazilian churches in the Riverview-Brandon area, so they are hoping to reach many Portuguese speaking people with the gospel.

ESSER – Lielson mentioned that ESSER had graduated 17 people from 5 different churches from their second cohort group of students.

Lielson presented the Tom Biles Tampa Bay Baptist Foundation grant to Pastor Larry Mouton from No Greater Love Church.

Director of Missions Report – Mike Kahn

Mike thanked Pastor JJ for allowing the Celebration to be at STF, as it was scheduled to be at another church but had to be cancelled due to a situation that couldn't be helped. Mike said that Pastor JJ and the STF team have always had a "can do" attitude and was always willing to step in and help. Mike thanked Pastor David and the praise team for a great job in leading worship.

Mike called Pastor Clarence Nathan (New Victory Baptist Church) to the platform and presented him with the Project Jerusalem offering.

Mike recognized and asked Pastor Paul Purvis, (President of the Florida Baptist Convention) to bring a greeting on behalf of the FBC. Pastor Paul said that the FBC has served over 551,000 meals through Disaster Relief during Hurricane Ian.

He gave a personal invitation to everyone to attend the Annual FBC Convention in Pensacola in November. Several well-known great speakers will be there along with Pastor Ken Whitten who will be bringing the main message.

Spanish Church Story

Lielson asked pastor Alfredo Estopinan (Unidos en Cristo) to share his story. Lielson interpreted for him. He thanked the TBBA for all their support in coming alongside him and supporting his ministry. He also said how much he appreciated Lielson for helping him find a place to worship, and stated how important it was to be a part of something bigger than yourself.

TBBA – Mike Kahn

Church Story

Pastor Carl Ellison (Wiregrass Church) shared that he had been part of the TBBA for six years and how much comradery with other pastors he had experienced in those six years. He stated that when he made the transition from the church he was in to replant and relaunch a church in the Wesley Chapel area the Association came alongside him to help guide and direct him.

The most recent events that positively affected and encouraged his life this year was being part of a leadership cohort through Chick-fil-a and a preaching conference that was hosted by Pastor Joe Hufstetler's church.

Mike reported on the activity of the Tampa Bay Baptist Foundation. At the last meeting of the TBBF, they voted to give \$87,000 to the FBC to Disaster Relief for the Ian Hurricane. Then a check for \$12,500 was given to the Associational Mission Strategist in Ft. Myers so he could bless churches in that association that are hurting because of the devastation in that area.

Mike directed attention to the bottom of page 2 of the Book of Reports where he mentioned the Multiplying Disciples Workshop that took place in January at Christ Fellowship Church. 48 pastors, wives and staff attended, helping pastors to develop their churches to make disciples who make disciples in their church. Out of this workshop, two groups of pastors have been meeting and eight pastors graduated and have been discipled and most of them are discipling others in their churches. Another discipling group is starting in November.

Church Story

Pastor Joseph Hufstetler (Destination Church). They have relocated their church from Faith Baptist to relaunch in east Tampa (name change from Faith to Destination Church).

Pastor Joe attended the Multiplying Disciples Conference in January and he introduced and implemented the "Multiplying" book to disciple his church members. He stated that some of his people are ready to start disciplying other people. God has used this along with other things to triple their church size. They have also had 25 baptisms since Easter.

Mike brought attention to the last page of the Book of Reports. The TBBA is striving to provide resources to churches to implement how to show and share Jesus. The TBBA has established two different strategies to do this, as shown on the last page. Mike talked how the more detailed strategy was represented by the Bentley, which is (All for One). This strategy is eight sessions long that includes homework and accountability.

Mike then talked about the Beetle (What If/PLEASE) which is a simpler strategy which was designed to be used by lots of church members and can be taught from the pulpit on Sunday

mornings. <u>Praying</u> for lost people, <u>Loving</u> lost people, <u>Enjoying</u> lost people, <u>Assisting</u> lost people, <u>Sharing</u> with lost people, and <u>Engaging</u> with many.

Mike introduced the speaker, Dr. Ben Mandrell with Lifeway Christian Resources. Prior to being with Lifeway, he was a pastor in Nashville for eight years and more recently was led of the Lord to plant a church in Colorado.

Transition to brief Business Meeting

At this time, there was a brief time of business. Pastor Zelvis Applin, Chairman of the Nominating Committee, made the following recommendations:

Nominating Committee Recommendation - Zelvis Applin

The Tampa Bay Baptist Association Nominating Committee has met and makes the nominations that are shown in your Book of Reports. These nominations were unanimously approved at the September 19, 2022 Executive Committee meeting. Attention was directed to the lines marked 2022-2025 under each committee to see the names of the new nominees. Our committee recommends that these nominated individuals be approved as TBBA leaders as shown in the Book of Reports.

Since this recommendation comes from a standing committee of the TBBA, no additional motion was required. Since there were no questions for discussion, a vote was taken and all were in favor.

Stewardship Committee Recommendation – Pastor Carl Ellison

The Tampa Bay Baptist Association Stewardship Committee has met and recommends the approval of the proposed 2022-2023 budget that can be found in the Book of Reports on page 13. This budget was unanimously approved at the September 19, 2022 Executive Committee meeting. Carl took a few minutes to present an overview and a few highlights from the Stewardship Committee. Carl mentioned that the Tampa Bay Baptist Foundation will be substantially supplementing the income of the TBBA with \$50,000.

Since this recommendation comes from a standing committee of the TBBA, no additional motion is required. Since there was no question for discussion, a vote was taken and all were in favor.

Carl invited Pastor Justin Perry to the platform to make his recommendations for the Credentials Committee.

Credentials Committee - Pastor Justin Perry - Recommendation

The Credentials Committee members received and reviewed the Articles of Incorporation, the church budget, and the Bylaws of Palabra de Vida (Word of Life Spanish Church). The credentials

Committee met with Pastor Erick Santallana and Elder Mario Figueroa and asked them many questions pertaining to doctrine and church polity. This church will have Carrollwood Baptist Church and Pastor Joe Alain as their sponsoring church and pastor. The Credentials Committee recommends that Palabra de Vida be received into full fellowship with our Association at the 2023 Annual Celebration in accordance with the TBBA Constitution. This Credentials information is show on page 4 in the Book of Reports.

Since this recommendation comes from a standing committee of the TBBA no additional motion is required. Since there were no questions for discussion, a vote was taken and all were in favor.

Credentials Committee – Pastor Justin Perry – Recommendation

At our October, 2021 Annual Celebration, One Another Ministry was approved to be accepted into the Tampa Bay Baptist Association into full fellowship at our 2022 Annual Celebration in accordance with the TBBA Constitution. The Credentials Committee recommends that One Another Ministry be received into full fellowship into our association tonight.

Since the recommendation comes from a standing committee of the TBBA, no additional motion is required. Since there were no questions for discussion a vote was taken and all were in favor.

Nominations for Moderator-Elect Pastor Tim Encinosa

Pastor Tim Encinosa of West Shore Church was invited to make his nomination for Moderator Elect. His nomination was Pastor Don Grantham (University Baptist). There was a second to the nomination and since there were no other nominations, a vote was taken and all were in favor of Pastor Don Grantham becoming the Moderator-Elect for 2022-23.

Mike thanked Pastor Carl Ellison, Moderator-Elect, for his assistance, since Pastor Dan Reid (Moderator) couldn't be in attendance.

Mike reminded everyone that our 2023 Annual Celebration will be at Harvest Baptist Fellowship at 4pm for dinner, and 5pm for the celebration on Sunday, October 15, 2023.

Mike asked Pastor Carl Ellison, our Moderator Elect, to close with a word of prayer. This concluded our 2022 Annual Celebration.

REPORTS

DIRECTOR OF MISSIONS REPORT - Mike Kahn

Encouraging and Equipping Pastors, Planters, Leaders

Pastors and leaders were encouraged and equipped in many different ways this past year.

Encouraging Pastors

Mission Hill Church invited the TBBA to partner with them to invite church pastors and wives to attend a Johnny Hunt date night on September 30, 2021 at the Temple Terrace Golf & Country Club. About 70 people enjoyed a great Cuban dinner, fellowship, gifts, and an opportunity to hear Dr. Hunt share his heart.

We had an in-person Annual Celebration in October of 2021 (the 2020 celebration was via Zoom). About 250 people attended the event at FBC Tampa and Eric Cummings was the guest preacher (via Zoom).

After cancelling the 2020 Annual Pastors & Wives Christmas party at the Puleos due to COVID, we were able to celebrate again at the Puleos on December 6, 2021. Over 80 pastors and wives attended even though some missed due to ongoing COVID concerns.

Mission Hill Church partnered with the TBBA to host a 2022 Prayer Summit that was led by Daniel Henderson. It ran from March 28 in the evening through March 30 lunch. The TBBA continues to offer these prayer summits so that pastors can be spiritually and emotionally refreshed and then pastor their church members out of a vibrant, healthy relationship with God.

On August 3, 2022 we took 40 pastors and guests to a free Rays baseball game. Each person received a Rays cap and money for lunch and parking.

We held our 2022 annual Pastors & Wives Retreat at Innisbrook on September 15-17, 2022 with a smaller number (15 couples) in attendance so that social distancing can be maintained. Darin Saley was the speaker.

TBBA pastors continued to gather in person, once a month in various parts of our county to cry out to the Lord in repentance and to ask Him for personal revival, church-wide revival, and to send a great spiritual awakening in our country. We prayed at the three locations listed below:

- Various churches Elbert Nasworthy
- Southside Baptist Church Brandon Dan Reid
- Various churches Eloy Rodriguez (Spanish)

Difficult Church Situations

Some churches continue to struggle and drastically decline and we advise them on what the best course of action is for the future of these churches. Some of these situations are mentioned below:

- Wellswood BC - After many conversations and meetings over a period of a few years, the church members chose in 2021 to sell the property to a Christian Company so that the sanctuary will be used as a future church plant "incubator". Wellswood's last Sunday was Easter, 2022. All assets have been distributed to various Southern Baptist and other evangelical ministries.

- Faith BC – Due to their buildings being in terrible condition, the church voted to sell their property and relocate. They are currently meeting in a rented facility near Highways 60 and 301 and have baptized 25 people since Easter of 2022.

- Journey Church Brandon – TBBA staff continue to advise the church as they raise money (over \$1 million), demolish old buildings, and build a multi-purpose worship center on the old Tropical Acres BC property.

- Palm Ave BC – The church averages around ten people in attendance each week. The TBBA continues to try to get the church to agree to accepting outside help.

- The Heights Church – The church buildings were in poor condition so the church voted prior to COVID to sell the property and relocate nearby. Then COVID and a church split left the church in a very difficult place. They couldn't get out of the sale and the struggling church voted to disband. The assets were given to various Southern Baptist ministries.

Equipping Pastors and Leaders Training

Many training opportunities have been provided for pastors and leaders this past year.

All for One Evangelism Training

The TBBA continues to train pastors and church leaders to use the free *All for One* lifestyle evangelism curriculum to equip their church members to show and share Jesus as a daily habit. - Friendship BC - On September 16-17, 2021 about forty members were trained in an All for One evangelism 8-hour intensive.

- Belmont BC - On October 28-29, 2021 twelve members were trained in an All for One evangelism 8-hour intensive.

- No Greater Love BC - On November 20, 2021 thirty members were trained in an All for One evangelism 8-hour intensive.

- Northwest Coast Baptist Association – On September 9-10, 2022 twenty-nine pastors and leaders were trained in an All for One evangelism 8-hour intensive. This training was filmed so that it can be offered to any church to use throughout the country.

Multiplying Disciples Workshop

On January 27, 2022 the TBBA put on a five-hour Multiplying Disciples Workshop for Pastors & Church Staff at Christ Fellowship Church. 48 pastors, wives, and staff attended. At the workshop the TBBA staff offered to personally disciple pastors for 20 sessions so that the pastors in turn could start a triad disciple making ministry at their churches. Two groups of pastors have since been discipled and most of them are discipling others in their churches. The next pastors group

starts to meet on November 3, 2022. This will be repeated twice a year with two TBBA staff members.

What If? PLEASE Evangelism Training

In addition to developing the *All for One* Evangelism curriculum, the TBBA created a simpler evangelism curriculum. It is called What If? PLEASE. It includes a What If? PLEASE brochure and a PLEASE bookmark. It was presented at three training events (West Broad Street - 11 attendees, Harvest Baptist Fellowship – 45 attendees, Simmons Loop -11 attendees). There have been other small group training events for Idlewild, South Hills, Southside Sun City, Ebenezer Haitian, and more.

In addition, a training event was filmed at Idlewild and the four videos and an electronic version of the brochure have been emailed to all of the TBBA churches and leaders.

A number of TBBA churches have already launched the What If? PLEASE evangelism strategy (Wiregrass, West Broad Street, Harvest Baptist Fellowship, South Hills, Carrollwood, Eben-Ezer Haitian, University, Simmons Loop) and more are considering doing so.

Preaching Conferences

On May 25-26 and on June 30, 2022 Dr. Rick Blackwood taught two levels of a preaching conference called Leading from the Pulpit. It was taught at Destination Church. Dr. Blackwood was the Lead Pastor of Christ Fellowship in Miami for over 25 years.

<u>IMB</u>

IMB partnered with Calvary Clearwater to put on an International Missions' training on October 7, 2021. About 60 people attended with about 10 people attending from the TBBA.

Marriage Training

On November 6, 2021 Darin Saley taught church leaders the Adventures in Marriage curriculum so that the leaders can start a Marriage small group ministry for their church members.

On February 5, 2022 Darin Saley taught church leaders the Start Smart curriculum so that the leaders can start a pre-marital ministry for engaged couples at their churches.

- *Bless Every Home* Prayer Ministry - The TBBA staff has continued to individually promote this incredible neighborhood prayer ministry to pastors and leaders. They will continue to do this ministry until every home is repeatedly prayed for by name by a Christ-follower.

The Church Planting Catalyst serves in concert with the DOM to assist our churches in planning, developing leaders, and planting new churches.

New Church Starts from October 2021 – September 2022

Extraordinary Church – Pastor James Blewett has begun a new church gathering at: 1700 E. Bloomingdale Ave, Valrico, FL 33596

The Church at Channelside – Pastor John Antonucci has begun a new church gathering at: 615 Channelside Dr, Suite 207, Tampa, FL 33602

New Churches Credentialed from October 2021 – September 2022

The Tampa Bay Baptist Association Credentials Committee met with Pastor Erik Santallana of Palabra de Vida. The Credentials Committee recommended that this church be received into our Association. The Executive Committee voted to receive them.



LANGUAGE MINISTRY CATALYST REPORT - Lielson Penido

The Language Ministry Catalyst serves in concert with the DOM to assist our ethnic churches and church plants (non-English speaking) in all phases of ministry.

Palabra de Vida Baptist Church

Since the birth of Palabra de Vida church with former Pastor Daniel Puerto, we have been working closely with the pastoral team especially Pastor Erick Santallana. In the past few months, we have been working with Pastor Mario Figueroa and Pastor Erick Santallana to help them with the right documents and advice as they pursue the joining of the Tampa Bay Baptist Association.

Chin Community Church of Tampa

We have been helping Pastor Reuben Hrang and his church recently as they are trying to sell their building and rent a temporarily location until they find a permanent location for their growing church.

Iglesia de Odessa

We came alongside a new church plant under the leadership of Pastor Ray Sanabria to help them for almost 7 months, to organize and lead the worship team until they found a permanent worship leader. In March 2022 God sent a new and young musician from South America to help with the worship.

Hispanic Men's Conference

On June 12 we had our Hispanic Men's retreat at the Tampa Bay Baptist Conference center with 98 men participating. Our special guest was Pastor Rogney Paz from Ocala. We also had 3 panelists participate from our TBBA - Pastor Eloy Rodriguez (Idlewild Español), Pastor Jaime Lopez (Bell Shoals Español) and Pastor Lielson Penido (TBBA). On October 21 and 22 of 2022 we are returning to an in-person men's retreat. This retreat will be held at the Lake Yale Baptist Conference center. Our special guest is pastor Luis Gabriel Cesar Isunza, lead pastor of the FBC Distrito Federal, Mexico. Our goal is to have at least 250 men.

Monthly Pastors' Prayer Meetings

Our goal is to meet every first Saturday of the month at 9 am in different locations when possible. Our goal is to have as many pastors as possible participating in our prayer meetings since we know the importance for unity through praying for one another. We have a good solid core group since we changed our day and format. Pastor Eloy has been the one in charge of organizing and arranging the location for our monthly meetings.

ESSER Spanish Biblical Institute

In the midst of the pandemic, ESSER continues to be strong. Since our first graduation back in 2017, many former ESSER students are continuing their theological studies. We are so honored and blessed to see what God has done in our midst. Our second cohort group of students that started back in February 2020 had their final graduation on July 16, 2022. We had 17 graduates from 5 different churches.

Church Planting

Since February, we have been helping a new Spanish work in the Brandon area. A young Spanish pastor who for almost 4 years was helping a Spanish ministry in one of our association churches, felt the need and call to start a new Spanish church. So, after several months of meetings and counsel, God opened a door to start a new work at Central Baptist Church in Brandon. Pastor Leskys is now residing in Miami and partnering with NAMB, but every 15 days he is coming to Brandon to assist the church. Once he finishes, he will move back with his family to dedicate totally to the new Spanish work in the Brandon area.

Since December of last year (2021) I have been personally involved in a church planting among Portuguese speaking people. We started meeting in a café in February of 2022, thanks to the generosity of pastor James Blewett and Extraordinary church in Valrico. But later on, we decided to meet in our homes on Sunday mornings. After almost seven months of meeting in our homes, God opened the door for us to meet at the FBC of Riverview.



ADMINISTRATIVE COMMITTEE REPORT

The Administrative Committee received Associational staff performance reviews in the mail from the Executive Director of Missions. The committee then met once with the Executive Director of Missions to discuss the performance reviews and to talk about Personnel issues. The committee also met personally with the Director of Missions to give him his annual evaluation, which was

favorable. Based on the Director of Missions' recommendation, the Administrative Committee recommended to the Stewardship committee that modest raises be provided for the TBBA staff and the two Tampa Bay Baptist Conference Center staff members.



BAPTIST COLLEGIATE MINISTRIES – BCM – Jay Sanders, Director

It's the 62nd year of ministry for the BCM at the University of South Florida. I am thrilled to report to you that God is still showing up and showing out through this ministry at USF. This Fall alone we have seen twenty-four students indicate a decision for Christ.

As a ministry we desire to shape students into leaders who influence the culture. This year we've witnessed a real hunger among our students to be used by God to see their college campus, local church, and culture impacted by Christ.

A core of them are locked in as leaders at the BCM, and in their local churches. Each one of them are getting a fully immersed experience that will equip them with the necessary leadership and ministry principles to lead at a high capacity in ministry and the marketplace someday.

By God's grace we have seen sustained engagement and growth in the BCM ministry. While we are thrilled to see more students commit to being a part of the BCM. • Partial funding for the TBBA Preaching Conference that was led by Pastor Rick Blackwood at Destination Church on May 25-26 and on June 30, 2022. There were 25 preachers in attendance.

• Funding to print more All for One lifestyle evangelism curriculum for pastors and leaders.

• Funding to print 2,000 What If? PLEASE brochures and bookmarks for pastors to use to launch a PLEASE evangelism strategy in their churches.

New Victory Baptist Church received grants from the Annual Project Jerusalem fund that is provided through the Foundation.

The Foundation's \$2,500 Annual Tom Biles award was given to No Greater Love Baptist Church.
