PROCEEDINGS

The 114th Annual Session of the Tampa Bay Baptist Association opened at 5:00 pm November 3, 2024 at Christ Fellowship.

Pastor Bruce Moore, pastor of Christ Fellowship, welcomed everyone and opened with a word of prayer.

Pastor and Moderator, Don Grantham (University Baptist Church), called the meeting to session of the Tampa Bay Baptist Association. Pastor Don stated that the Celebration would be first then the business of the TBBA would follow. Pastor Don introduced the No Greater Love choir that sang two worship songs.

Church Planting Catalyst Report - Lielson Penido

Lielson highlighted two new church starts from page 3 of the Book of Reports.

Pastor John Antonucci of the Church at Channelside and trustee Mike Stubbs at San Antonio Community Church are new church starts. Our Credentials Committee recommended that these churches be received into our Association, and the Executive Committee voted to receive them. Lielson also said that the Association was working with Pastor Scott Talley at First Baptist Church of Lutz to help them plant a Spanish church.

Lielson then called Philip Whitten to come present his report from One More Child.

Phillip shared that last year, they had the privilege of serving 250,259 children through their Foster care, anti-trafficking, child hunger, single moms and family support programs. 19,580,059 children and individuals served 143,334 additional individuals impacted through advocacy, trainings, awareness, and volunteering meals provided, nationally and globally. One More Child continues to meet needs and show the love of Christ locally and globally.

Church Transition story – Pastor Darryl Williamson (Living Faith Bible Fellowship)

Pastor Darryl shared that the TBBA was more than an Association to him, it was a movement of people that has a heart for evangelism and discipleship starting with Pastor Mike who is a godly example and leader of the Association. **Pastor Darryl also spoke of how the Tampa Bay Baptist Foundation had helped them financially with their building.**

Lielson presented Pastor Wayne Kirkland of Buchanan Baptist Church a check for \$2,500 for the Tom Biles TBBF grant.

J15 Story

Pastor Tim Encinosa (WestShore Baptist Church)

Pastor Tim shared how being a Pastor is something that every Pastor loves to do. He said that the position, however, is a lonely one. He shared how J15 has been such a blessing to him because

every first Thursday of the month they meet as pastors and share some of life's deepest challenges of being a pastor. He spoke about how they pray together, share together and eat together. He encouraged other Pastors to join them as he stated that they need each other. He thanked Mike for establishing J15 as it had been such a blessing to him.

Lielson shared that on November 2 they had a Spanish Women's Conference at Carrollwood Baptist with 250 women in attendance.

VBS Training was offered in Spanish in partnership with Lifeway to our Spanish churches in April of 2024 at Iglesia Bautista Bethel with 55 people attending.

ShareWord Global Training- We partnered with ShareWord Global to offer relational evangelism training for Spanish churches and a Portuguese speaking church in May and June 2024.

Associational Missions Strategist Report

Mike thanked Bruce Moore and the Christ Fellowship Praise Team for hosting the Celebration.

Disciple Making Story

Pastor Scott Talley (First Baptist of Lutz)

Pastor Scott shared a testimony of how the TBBA and Mike Kahn had been such an encouragement to him especially in partnering with him regarding disciple making. He shared how being a part of the discipleship program has made a difference in his life and thanked Mike for his endeavors in continuing to help pastors grow and share their faith.

Mike spoke about J15 which is a Pastors Gatherings which involves three things: Reminding Together (In God's Word), Praying Together, and Fellowshiping Together (eating lunch). These gatherings have been well-attended (Tampa 16-22 in attendance; Brandon 6-10 in attendance). He stated that these gatherings make it easier for pastors and planters to connect with others in genuine, accountable friendships. These gatherings meet in Tampa on the first Thursday of every month and in Brandon on the 4th Wednesday of every month.

Mike mentioned that in June the TBBA had a new event, Pastors' and Wives' Date night at Maggiano's Restaurant which was well attended.

Evangelism Training

In May of 2024, a ShareWord Global relational evangelism training was offered in Spanish and in Portuguese and then again in English and Spanish at Idlewild Baptist Church on June 1. Over 250 people were trained at this event.

On August 22-23, Pastor H.B.Charles led a Preaching Conference for almost 50 TBBA pastors at Living Faith Bible Fellowship.

Mike acknowledged David Russo with Florida Baptist Financials and Bob Magruder with disciple making coaching.

Storm Stories

Pastor David Oates (Sea Glass Church) shared that since his church is less than a mile from the Bay, many of his church members homes were damaged from the hurricane along with his own home. He thanked God for the outpouring of many volunteers that ministered to about 5,000 individuals and families during this time.

Pastor Paul Purvis (Mission Hill Church) partnered with the Mississippi Disaster Relief and other organizations to serve well over 10,000 meals and provide thousands of care packages to families over a ten-day period. Many other TBBA churches did similar things in their communities.

Pastor Rafael Sanchez (Iglesia Bautista Bethel) sent several of his members to help in the cleanup of the TBCC (Conference Center) from the storm.

Stewardship Committee Recommendation (Mike Kahn)

“I will take a few minutes to present an overview and some highlights of the 2025 budget that is shown on page 13 of the Book of Reports. The Tampa Bay Baptist Association Stewardship Committee recommends the approval of the proposed 2025 TBBA budget that you have before you. This budget was unanimously approved at our September 26, 2024 Executive Committee Meeting.

Moderator:

Since this recommendation comes from a standing committee of the TBBA, no additional motion is required. Since there no questions for discussion, all were in favor.

Mike Kahn was invited to make the recommendations for the Credentials Committee for action. The request will be communicated at the Annual Celebration.

The requests to withdraw from these two churches was presented to the Credentials Committee on September 4, 2024 and also at our September 16, 2024 Executive Meeting. In adherence with the TBBA Constitution, I am communicating to you tonight at our Annual Celebration that these two churches will be removed from the TBBA per their request. A vote may not be necessary, but we will vote anyway.

Moderator:

In adherence with the TBBA Constitution, I ask for a motion to remove these churches from the TBBA. There was a second to the motion. Since there were no questions for discussion, all were in favor.

Mike Kahn for Justin Perry

In 2023, four churches applied to join the TBBA.

- South Hills Church (Pastor Zelvis Applin)
- Upper Room Church/Spanish (Pastor Lesky Perez)
- Willow Bend Community Church (Pastor Geoff Gordon)
- Extraordinary Church (Pastor James Blewett)

These churches were recommended to the Executive Committee in September of 2023 and were approved to join the TBBA, with the caveat that two of the churches, Willow Bend Church and Extraordinary Church would be required to meet with the Associational Missions Strategist to amend their Bylaws before being admitted into the TBBA. The four churches were also presented at the 2023 Annual Celebration. The Willow Bend Church and Extraordinary Church pastors thought that their churches could complete these bylaw amendments within the past year, but they have not been able to do so. Therefore, only South Hills Church and Upper Room Church are being presented at tonight's 2024 Annual Celebration for full fellowship into the TBBA. Hopefully the other two churches will soon complete their bylaw revisions and be presented for full fellowship into the TBBA in 2025.

Moderator:

No vote is needed, and South Hills Church and Upper Room Church are admitted into full fellowship into the TBBA.

ASSOCIATIONAL MISSIONS STRATEGIST REPORT - Mike Kahn

Encouraging Pastors

For over nine years the TBBA has offered monthly Pastors' Prayer gatherings in English in Tampa and Brandon, and in Spanish in Tampa. We continued to do that until July, 2023. The prayer gatherings were good but because they were only a prayer time the TBBA staff felt like it was time for a change. Therefore, on August 3, 2023 we launched the first monthly J15 Pastors' Gathering that consists of pastors Reminding Together (in God's Word), Praying Together, and Fellowshiping Together (eating lunch). In September we also started a Brandon J15 each month. It is desired that the monthly J15 Pastors' Gatherings will make it easier for pastors and planters to connect with others in genuine, accountable friendships so that they can be spiritually, relationally, and emotionally healthy and thereby better lead their churches to impact our county with the gospel message.

Evangelism training

The TBBA continues to expand their options for personal evangelism strategies for churches to use to train their members to often show and share Jesus with lost people. The *All for One* Lifestyle Evangelism Training now has three parts that have been video-taped. There is an Overview of *All for One* (11-minute video), a Deeper Dive for *All for One* (2 hour walk through the workbook), and a 6.5-hour Intensive for *All for One*. The Overview video, the four Deeper Dive videos, and the Intensive training videos and *All for One* workbooks are all available for free at tbba.org/all-for-one and tbba.org/all-for-one-intensive.

Lielson and Mike developed another evangelism resource for churches. It is called The Resource Guide and it includes ten great personal evangelism resources that pastors and leaders can use to train their people to often have spiritual and gospel conversations with others. Mike taught all ten strategies to pastors and leaders on June 26, 2023 and July 24, 2023. The training was filmed and edited and is available to be viewed at tbba.org/the-resource-guide.

Boe Ellis and Mike updated the TBBA website (tbba.org) so that it now includes an Evangelism tab at the top of the page. When a person clicks on the tab they see the below three choices:

1. The Resource Guide
2. What If?/P.L.E.A.S.E.
3. All for One

All the evangelism strategies are packaged in such a way that a pastor or leader can read about them, watch videos, follow along in workbooks, and then decide whether or not one of these strategies could help their church members frequently share Jesus.

Church Planting & Revitalizations

Mike met with six pastors whose churches are actively training their members or non-members to possibly plant a church. They met with Justin Perry, Edgar Aponte, Eloy Rodriguez, Bruce Moore, JJ Johnson, and Darryl Williamson. The TBBA staff will continue to work with these pastors so that other TBBA churches can benefit from these churches' multiplying efforts.

Mike met numerous times with the Journey Church Brandon elders and deacons as they wrestled with what the future of their church should be. They unanimously voted to merge with and give their church property to Fishhawk Fellowship Church so that a new church plant can be launched in Riverview. The finalization of all of this will probably take place in late October.

Mike continues to work with a number of struggling churches that are on the brink of shutting their doors. This includes Palm Avenue BC, Tampa Shores Community Church, Concord BC, New Tampa BC, and New Beginnings BC. He continues to talk to their pastors, interim pastors, or deacons about seeking outside help for their churches.

Pastors (more)

On December 5, 2022, we celebrated our Annual Pastors & Wives Christmas party at the Puleo farm in Lutz.

On May 25, 2023 we hosted a free Rays baseball game to honor Ken Whitten, as he had transitioned away from pastoring Idlewild in January, 2023. About 30 TBBA pastors, FBC staff, and family members attended the game and greatly enjoyed themselves.

November 17, 2022, February 16, 2023, and May 18, 2023 we hosted a luncheon for the larger church pastors at the Columbia Restaurant so that they could encourage each other, share challenges they are facing, and share ideas that they are using to lead their churches.

We held our 2023 Annual Pastors & Wives Retreat at Innisbrook on August 10-12, 2023 with 15 couples in attendance. It was a great time of marital refreshment for the couples. Darin Saley was once again the speaker.

Training

On February 12, 2023 Mike taught over 60 adults and adolescents about evangelism at Bethel Baptist Haitian Church.

The TBBA staff attended the Florida Baptist Convention's Challenge 2025 event on February 28, 2023, along with about 40 TBBA pastors. The theme was on personal evangelism.

The TBBA staff recruited about 20 pastors, wives, and leaders to attend the Exponential Conference in Orlando from March 7-9, 2023. It was sold out with 5,000 attendees and the emphasis of the conference was on personal evangelism, making disciples, and church planting.

Mike continues to disciple pastors in triad groups for twenty sessions. Lielson has gone through a triad study twice with him and some pastors, and both of them will begin discipling 3-4 pastors for 20 sessions starting in November 2023. The intent is for the pastors who have completed the discipling groups to begin to find 3-4 men or two couples at their churches to disciple, so that overall, we will see a movement in our churches of people discipling people.

For the second year in a row, we partnered with Pastor Johnny Carr and South Tampa Fellowship to offer a 12-month co-hort to six pastors. The focus is on leading like Jesus led. Johnny uses the Heart2Serve curriculum developed by Chick-Fil-A to train the six pastors on two Fridays during the year and then he meets one on one with them via Zoom ten times per year.

On July 29 the TBBA hosted a Smaller Church Worship Enhancement Workshop that was led by Lielson Penido, Pastor Mark Warren, and Danielle Warren. Almost 20 pastors and lay leaders attended and heard about how to use technology to enhance worship.

Ken Whitten, the new Director of Pastoral Leadership with NAMB, led a workshop on August 14, 2023 at Northgate BC for over 25 pastors and shared about the resources that NAMB is making available to help and encourage pastors to be renewed in Jesus and serve Him effectively through their local churches.

On November 7-8, 2023 Dr. Stephen Rummage will return to lead a Preaching Conference for TBBA pastors. Dr. Rummage has served as a preaching professor at SEBTS in the past and is a great teacher of preachers.



CHURCH PLANTING CATALYST REPORT – Lielson Penido

The Church Planting Catalyst serves in concert with the AMS to assist our churches in planning, developing leaders, and planting new churches.

New Church Starts from October 2022 – September 2023

Upper Room Church (Spanish) – Pastor Lesky Perez has begun a new church gathering at Central Baptist Church Brandon.

Connection Baptist Church (Portuguese) – Pastor Lielson Penido has taken over a new church plant in September of 2022 and they meet at FBC Riverview.

New Churches Credentialed from October 2022 – September 2023

The Tampa Bay Baptist Association Credentials Committee met with Pastor Zelvis Applin of South Hills Church, Pastor James Blewett of Extraordinary Church, Pastor Lesky Perez of Upper Room Church (Spanish), and Pastor Geoff Gordon of Willow Bend Community Church. The Credentials Committee recommended that these churches be received into our Association. The Executive Committee voted to receive them.



LANGUAGE MINISTRY CATALYST REPORT – Lielson Penido

The Language Ministry Catalyst serves in concert with the AMS to assist our ethnic churches and church plants (non-English speaking) in all phases of ministry.

Iglesia Bautista Bethel

Lielson and Mike worked closely together with Pastor Rafael Sanchez (Iglesia Bautista Bethel) and Pastor Steve Hogan (Hope Bible Church) to assist Hope Bible in giving their property and buildings to Iglesia Bautista Bethel. This was formally done on October 2, 2023.

Lielson had numerous meetings for about two years with Pastor Rob Allison as FBC Wesley Chapel wanted to start a Spanish ministry at FBC. David Endara has been voted as a Church planter for a Spanish Church at FBC Wesley Chapel. David is already helping with the music at the English Speaking service but also has started a Spanish Bible Study on Sundays.

Hispanic Men's Conference

In October of 2022 Lielson coordinated a men's retreat at Lake Yale Baptist Conference Center. They had 128 men present and their guest speaker was Pastor Luis Gabriel Cesar Isunza, pastor of the FBC of Ciudad de Mexico. Lielson worked with some TBBA pastors to offer a Spanish Men's Retreat at Word of Life on October 6-7, 2023. Pastor Edgar Aponte (Idlewild Baptist Church) was the preacher and 174 men attended.

Monthly Pastors' Prayer Meetings

The pastors meet for prayer every first Saturday of the month at 9 am in different locations, when possible. The desire is to have as many pastors as possible participating in these prayer meetings since we know the importance for unity through praying for one another. We have a good solid core group since we changed our day and format. Pastor Eloy Rodriguez has been the one in charge of organizing and arranging the location for our monthly meetings.

ESSER Spanish Biblical Institute

In August of 2022, the TBBA discontinued their partnership with ESSER Spanish Biblical Institute. Idlewild Baptist Church took over the rights to administer ESSER locally instead of the TBBA. Many former ESSER students are continuing their theological studies through ESSER and we rejoice that Idlewild continues to offer this program.

TBBA ESPAÑOL

In June of 2023, the TBBA signed an agreement with the Theological Baptist Seminary of Araucaña, Chile. All classes are offered online at this time but we hope to offer some classes in person in the near future. We currently have 4 students.

Also in July of 2023, the TBBA agreed to work in partnership with Carolina University to offer an online Masters of Divinity Program in Spanish and Portuguese. The agreement will benefit many students who want further theological studies along with great incentives, discounts and easy forms of payments.

VBS Training

VBS training was offered in Spanish in partnership with Lifeway to our Spanish churches in April of 2023 at Iglesia Bautista Bethel, with 58 people attending.

Church Planting

Since February, 2023 Lielson has helped a new Spanish work in the Brandon area. He has worked closely with Pastor Lesky Perez. That work has resulted in a church plant that was formally launched on September 24, 2023.

Lielson has worked since late 2021 with Clovis Pause to plant a Brazilian Church in the Riverview area. Due to health issues, Clovis stepped away and Lielson has worked to launch this church plant in September of 2022 at FBC of Riverview.

ADMINISTRATIVE COMMITTEE REPORT

The Administrative Committee received Associational staff performance reviews in the mail from the Associational Missions Strategist.
