THANKS TO THE LORD & TO TBBA CHURCHES



Our TBBA staff is grateful to the LORD and the 150+ Tampa Bay Baptist Association churches for the privilege of humbly serving Him through our churches and church plants. What we get to do would not be possible without His powerful grace and the partnership and financial support of many churches. This time of year is a good time for me to share some of the highlights of what the LORD has recently done in and through the TBBA, the

churches, and plants.

- Since August of 2023, pastors have gathered each month to earnestly pray together, interact around a biblical topic, and then hang out and eat lunch together. These gatherings are called J15 (based on John 15) Pastors' Gatherings. There is a Tampa J15, a Brandon J15 and in June of 2025, Lielson Penido launched a Spanish J15. It is desired that the monthly J15 Pastors' Gatherings will make it easier for pastors and planters to connect with others in genuine friendships so that they can be spiritually, relationally, and emotionally healthy and thereby better lead their churches to impact our county with the gospel message.
- Hurricanes Helene and Milton caused damage to many TBBA churches. Some
 churches were flooded, some had roof damage, and some had structural
 damage due to fallen trees. We contacted many TBBA pastors to ask them
 about their buildings and their homes. The TBBA, and mostly the Tampa Bay
 Baptist Foundation, gave thousands of dollars to assist churches in need. Also,
 the TBBA staff contacted pastors to ask them to send volunteers to help other
 churches in need.
- In April, Dr. Bob Magruder spoke to about 30 pastors about Multiplying Disciples. Bob is serving full-time in the disciple making ministry and is assisting the TBBA by working with individual pastors to help them grow a disciple making culture in their churches. He has been following up with pastors who

attended the April meeting. As a result, he has been helping many TBBA pastors start and sustain a disciple making movement in their churches.

- In May, over 40 TBBA pastors and leaders met at Mission Hill Church for a 3
 hour Prayer Summit led by Pastor Paul Purvis. It was an intimate and powerful
 time with the LORD and each other. We enjoyed great fellowship and a lunch
 afterward.
- In May, Dr. Stephen Rummage led a Preaching Conference for about 35 TBBA
 pastors at Living Faith Bible Fellowship. It was an incredible time of learning
 how to study a biblical text and then let the sermon flow from the message of
 the text.
- In July, 84 pastors and wives enjoyed a wonderful date night at Maggianos Restaurant at the Westshore Mall. It was a family style meal with two appetizers, two salads, four main entrees, and two desserts. It was greatly enjoyed by all.
- We held our 2025 Annual Pastors & Wives Retreat at the Innisbrook Resort on July 31 August 2 with 13 couples in attendance. It was a great time of marital refreshment and equipping for the couples.
- The TBBA partnered with ShareWord Global to lead an evangelism training in 2024. They led a similar training at Mission Hill Church on August 23 that was attended by about 250 people. The training was offered in English, Spanish, and French. ShareWord Global is so positive about their partnership with the TBBA that they have hired an employee who lives in Tampa. This will enable them to offer similar evangelism training throughout the year to individual churches or groups of churches in our region.

In addition, there are a number of churches that are close to closing their doors or in need of other help. Below are a few of the churches we were able to assist.

- Palm Ave BC The church averages about eight elderly worshipers each Sunday.
 After many years of coming alongside these wonderful saints, the members have voted to ask Idlewild BC to help them. The two churches signed a Letter of Intent on May 7, 2025 for them to merge together. Idlewild is currently doing due diligence before signing formal documents to merge.
- Manhattan BC Pastor John Garbreana passed away in 2024 and we met with
 the Pastor Search Committee and told them that they needed to consider
 options for their future (full-time pastor, bi-vocational pastor, revitalization by
 another TBBA church, etc.). The church set up a council to evaluate what the
 Lord wanted for the church. There were many meetings with the council and
 their interim pastor, Boe Ellis. The church voted to merge with Christ Fellowship
 Church in March of 2025.
- Through many meetings with church elders the Lord opened the door for Kings Avenue BC to merge with Extraordinary Church (SBC church) and that merger took place in August of 2025.
- Buchanan BC Former deacon, Wayne Kirkland was called as the interim and then permanent pastor over 1.5 years ago. The church is declining due to some deaths of elderly congregants and is surviving on financial reserves that will run

out before the end of 2025. We have been working with Pastor Wayne and the leaders to help them make a godly decision about the church's future.

Partnerships

- For the fourth year in a row, we partnered with Pastor Johnny Carr and South Tampa Fellowship to offer a 12-month (Jan. - Dec.) co-hort to six pastors. The focus is on Leading like Jesus led. Johnny uses the Heart2Serve curriculum developed by Chick-Fila to train the six pastors on two Fridays during the year and then he meets one on one with them via Zoom ten times per year.
- We partnered with missionary Dennis Pethers who coached 8 pastors for one year on a monthly basis so that they can become disciple makers inside and outside their churches. The coaching was both impactful and encouraging and it ended in July.

Church Planting

• We are striving to work more closely with a few TBBA churches that are (1) already training members to possibly plant a church (2) or that are working to develop a Church Planting Network (3) or that are assisting members in planting churches. We have met and will continue to meet with pastors of these churches to listen to them and discover new ways that they can be assisted in their church planting work.

Again, we are grateful for your partnership and look forward to greater things for the gory of God in the days ahead.


